Methodology

Information about the poll

- Fieldwork dates: October 10-30, 2014
- ▶3, 885 completed interviews
- A nationally representative sample of Georgian speakers including Urban, Rural, East Georgia and West Georgia areas. Also additional representative samples of the self governing cities of Tbilisi, Telavi, Akhaltsikhe, Kutaisi, Zugdidi and Batumi
- ➤ The average margin of error is +/- 1.6%

Methodology

Sample design

- ➤ NDI and CRRC use a complex survey design:
 - ✓ **Stratification** dividing population in relatively homogenous sub-groups
 - ✓ Clustering randomly selecting small geographic areas for each sub-group (stratum)
- > Households are selected via random route sampling
- ➤ Respondents are selected using a Kish table
- > Randomly selected households and individuals are not substituted
- ➤ All interviews are conducted face-to-face

How NDI Survey is Conducted

At the first stage, CRRC randomly selects voting precincts in Georgia. Interviewers are sent there with given starting point, directions for walking, step size, number of contacts.



Interviewer randomly selectes households according to the given step size, e.g. every 3rd, 5th, 8th...

The respondent is selected randomly, with special method - so called Kish grid. Selected respondent cannot be replaced.






Interviewer conducts an interview with the selected household member. Intervewer uses tablet computer and a special software.

Interviewer submits the results via the internet to the special server.











CRRC cleans and analyses collected data, which later is presented to the public.


Public Opinion Poll Findings

Key Findings

- 64 % of Georgians believe there is currently no gender equality in Georgia
 - This number reaches 68% among youth
- 55% of citizens think having 17 women out of 150 members in parliament is too few
- 68% say they support the parliament adopting mandatory gender quota
- 70% of population think the number of women in parliament should be at least 30%
- Half of the population believes that increasing the number of women in parliament would have a positive impact on Georgia




Is there gender equality in Georgia? (q40 X Gender)






Is there gender equality in Georgia? (q40 X Age)




Do women and men in Georgia have equal opportunities to succeed in any field? (q41)




Do women and men in Georgia have equal opportunities to succeed in any field? (q41 X Gender)






Do women and men in Georgia have equal opportunities to succeed in any field? (q41 X Age)






How comfortable or uncomfortable would you feel with a woman as your immediate boss? (q45)















If there is only one child in a family, what gender would you prefer? (q49)








If there is only one child in a family, what gender would you prefer? (q49 X Gender)






















When you meet with your friends, do you discuss politics often, occasionally or never? (q7)




When you meet with your friends, do you discuss politics often, occasionally or never? (q7 X Gender)







How likely or unlikely are you to get involved in political life? (q8 X Gender)




How likely or how unlikely are you to get involved in political life in the future in the following ways? (q9 X Gender) Part 1




How likely or how unlikely are you to get involved in political life in the future in the following ways? (q9 X Gender) Part 2


























Do Georgian male politicians treat their female colleagues as equals, or not? (q28)




Do Georgian male politicians treat their female colleagues as equals, or not? (q28 X Gender)




Do Georgian female politicians treat their male colleagues as equals, or not? (q29)






All things being equal, who would you vote for in local office / in the parliament – a man or a woman? (q23/q24)







All things being equal, who would you vote for in the parliament – a man or a woman? (q24 X Gender)


How important or unimportant do you think it is for the party you support to have balanced representation of male and female candidates? (q31 X Gender)








Currently there are 133 male members of parliament out of 150 (89%). Do you think this is . . .? (q34)








What would be the best proportion of men and women members in parliament? (q35)





What kind of impact would increasing the number of women MPs have on Georgia? (q36 X Gender)






What kind of impact would increasing the number of women members of the local government have on your region? (q37 X Gender)
