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
Methodology

- A total of 1784 interviews were conducted in Serbia.
 - 1104 were conducted between August 18-21.
 - 680 were conducted between August 25-27.
 - The two sets of data were weighted and combined. The margin of error is +/ 2.32 percent and greater for subgroups.

 In the week since our first poll, Vojislav Kostunica and the Democratic Opposition of Serbia have held steady in their lead over Slobodan Milosevic and the SPS/JUL.

 In most cases, Kostunica has climbed a point or two and Milosevic has dropped.

- Similarly, in favorability, the Democratic Opposition of Serbia has climbed several points in a week.
- The group's favorable/unfavorable rating climbed from 45/36 to 48/33 in a week.

Major Findings – Serbia

• Poverty and social problems have been foremost in voters' minds over the past year and continue to be the largest concerns as elections approach.



How likely is it that you will vote in the next round of elections - is it absolutely certain, very likely, possible, not very likely or not at all likely?



• Vojislav Konstunica held his favorable/unfavorable rating steady, while Milosevic dropped slightly.


Are you familiar with him? (IF YES:) In general, do you have a very favorable, somewhat favorable, somewhat unfavorable or very unfavorable view of him? All voters

• Kostunica's lead has climbed to 16 points, bringing his numbers into the 40s. He still does not command a majority in the first round.


The election for President of Yugoslavia is scheduled for September 24. If that election were held today, for whom would you vote?

If the election were held today and there were only two candidates – Slobodan Milosevic and Vojislav Kostunica – for whom would you vote? <u>All voters</u>




• In parliamentary elections, the Democratic Opposition of Serbia is holding a 15-point lead.
