PESHAWAR, July 22: Public representatives came under criticism from the speakers who termed their failure with regard to the solution of their basic problems,

The public forum entitled "Good governance" organized jointly by National Democratic Institute for International Affairs and Centre for Civic Education, Pakistan here at the Peshawar Press Club on Tuesday.
