

Our Mission

People all over the world seek freedom, fairness, opportunity, and open, accountable government. These core elements of democracy are the foundations for strong societies, thriving economies, and a more secure world. We know that when people have a choice, they choose democracy. NDI strives for a world where people have a say in how they're governed and where leaders are accountable to their people — creating a more stable, peaceful and prosperous world for everyone.

Our Impact

NDI was founded in 1983, working in its early years to support democratic politics in Asia and Latin America. In the 1990s, after the fall of the Berlin Wall, NDI helped nations in Africa, across Europe, and elsewhere build democratic institutions after decades of oppression. Over four decades, NDI has helped thousands of local partners and tens of millions of people enjoy the benefits of living in a democratic society: governments that are better able to meet the needs of their people, and communities with higher life expectancies, lower infant mortality and greater economic growth. Freedom works!

NDI's efforts contribute to global stability and security by:

- Shrinking space for violent extremists and criminal organizations to recruit and operate
- Bridging divides that give rise to armed conflict
- Reducing irregular migration, and
- Cultivating better partners for private sector trade and investment.

Countries that are governed by democratic principles also help protect the vital interests of the United States: promoting stability, opening new markets and reducing the threats the American military faces from extremists and adversaries.

“America’s national security, economic strength and global leadership are best secured in a world where freedom prevails,” said NDI’s president, Tamara Cofman Wittes. **“NDI’s work is a strategic investment that benefits the American people and reflects their values.”**

Brutal regimes in Russia, China and Iran are using their influence to undermine trust in democracy and provoke conflict within societies — for the sake of their own power and advantage. In the Middle East, the Asia-Pacific, Africa and Latin America, forces opposed to democracy are threatening human freedom, hurting ordinary people, and provoking regional and global instability.

NDI supports citizens from all parts of society in their demand for freedom, economic opportunity and open and accountable government. NDI counters authoritarian influences that undermine freedom and democracy across the globe, and we help citizens resist oppressive governments. In conflict zones, we facilitate dialogue to address grievances, prevent terrorism and reduce mass migration. We promote digital safety and provide online tools to citizens that help make governments more efficient, fair and accountable.
