Making it happen at the Branch Office level

- ✓ Target: → potential new members
 - → Former members
- ✓ Identify one person in each branch office to:
- ✓ Work as a team: be Reasonable; Realistic; Flexible; Accountable; and Responsible
- ✓ Set aside ___ evenings a week and one morning a weekend from now to election day.
- maintain efficient record keepers to pass information and monitor process
- ✓ Ask members for financial support
