Survey Oversample Locations and Regions




Survey Methodology 1

- NDI Survey
 - Fieldwork dates: July 1 31, 2017
 - 5,125 completed interviews
 - The nationally representative sample was random at all stages:
 - Random selection of election precincts
 - Random selection of households via random route sampling
 - · Random selection of respondents within the households using modified Kish grid
 - Areas outside the control of the Ukrainian government were excluded
 - Six oversamples
 - Kyiv city [601]
 - Kharkiv city [601]
 - Khersonska Oblast [602]
 - Odesa city [601]
 - Lviv city [600]
 - Kramatorsk Region [600]
 - Quality control:
 - All interviewers received a four level training system which includes 16 hours of training
 - An independent network of controllers conducted quality control interviews
 - 31% of all interviews were checked by controllers
 - All 5,125 interviews were conducted using tablets


Survey Methodology 2

- The average margin of error for this survey is +/- 3%
- The margin of error is different for every response to every question in all surveys. In this presentation, the margin of error is shown for each question/option.
- This is shown in the example below:
 - A is statistically greater than B and C.
 - There is no statistical difference between B and C.
- Additionally, there has been a multi-variate regression analysis run on the data.
 Regression analysis estimates predictive, rather than causal, relationships among variables. The results of the regression have been added to slides in text boxes.



How important it is to you that Ukraine becomes a fully functioning democracy? "Very important/Important" only (q22 X Settlement)




How important is it to you that Ukraine becomes a fully functioning democracy? X "Very positive/Positive" attitude toward parties (q22 X q36) Part 1






In your opinion, who is more involved in political life, men or women? (q33)




In your opinion, who should be more involved in political life, men or women? (q34)




Different reasons are given for the fact that there are fewer women than men in elected office in Ukraine. Which, if any of the following statements do you agree with? (q35)





Some people expect that 'Third Maidan' will occur, others believe it will not. Do you expect more protests on that scale in the next year? (q73 X Settlement)








How has the situation changed in Ukraine since the Parliamentary elections in October 2014? "Better" only (q2) Part 1




How has the situation changed in Ukraine since the Parliamentary elections in October 2014? "Worse" only (q2) Part 1




Since the parliamentary elections in October 2014, would you say that in economic terms you and your family are...? "Worse off" only




In your opinion, do you think the current government is committed to reform? (q7)




How effective are current anti-corruption efforts in Ukraine? (q11)










Several options have been suggested to regulate trade with the occupied territories in the future. Which of the following do you agree with most? (q55)








Since July of 2015, many communities in Ukraine have gone through the amalgamation process. Has your community gone through amalgamation process? (q15)








By 2020, do you want/expect Ukraine to be...? (q48/q49)




Which, if any, of the following would you accept as the price for peace? (q57)




Do political parties currently do any of the following? What would you like them to do? (q70/q71)














