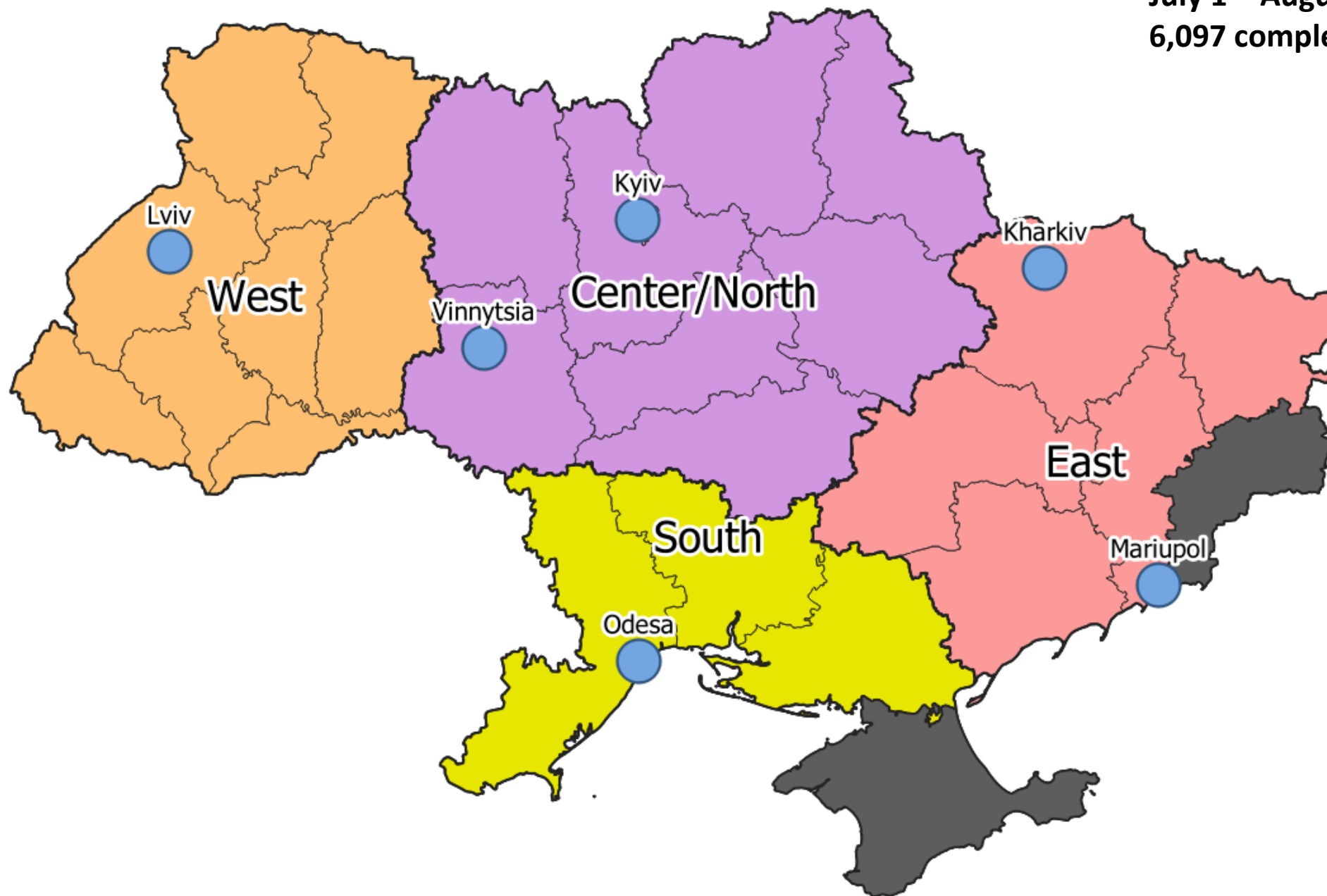

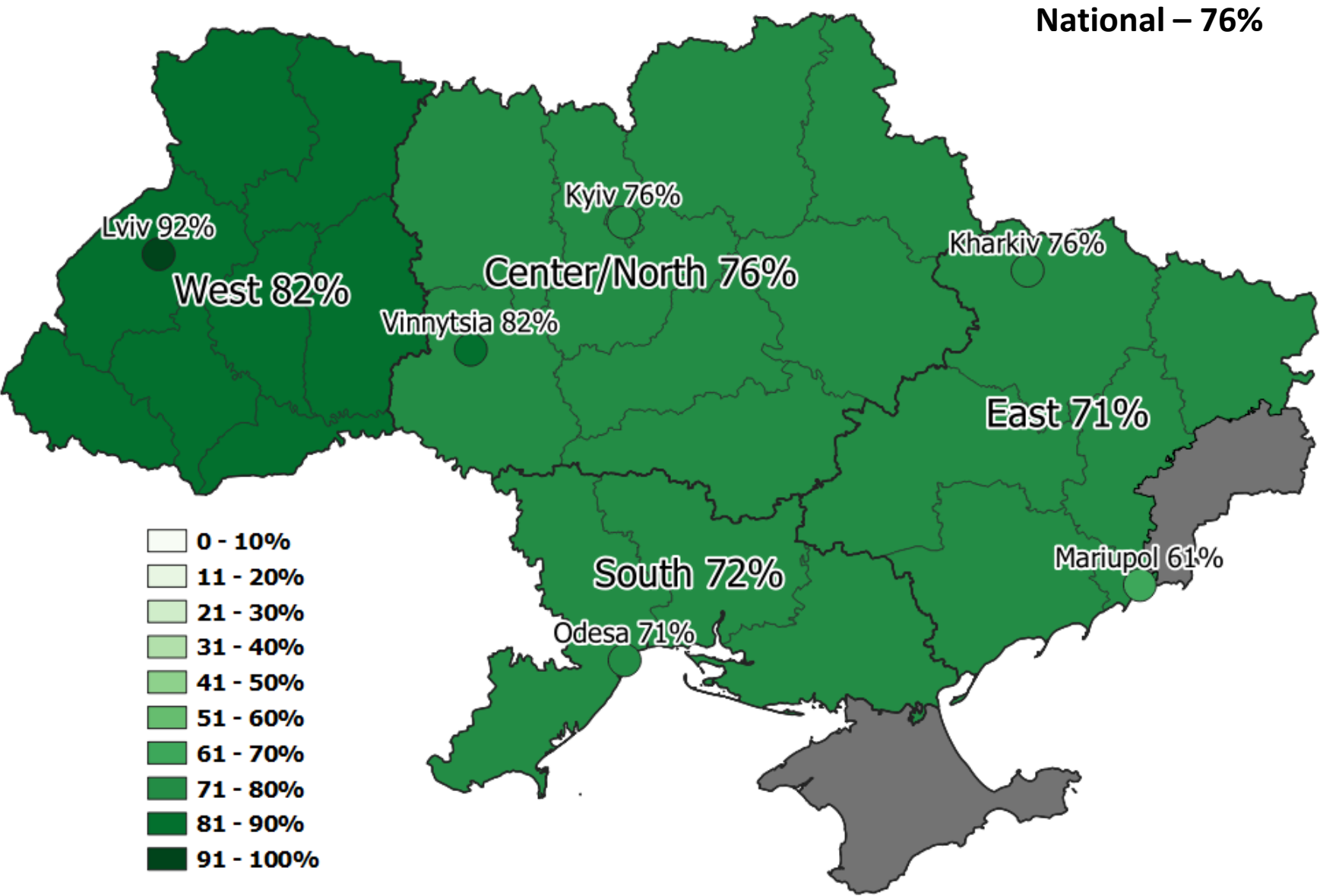

How important is it to you that Ukraine becomes a fully functioning democracy? (q6 X Settlement)

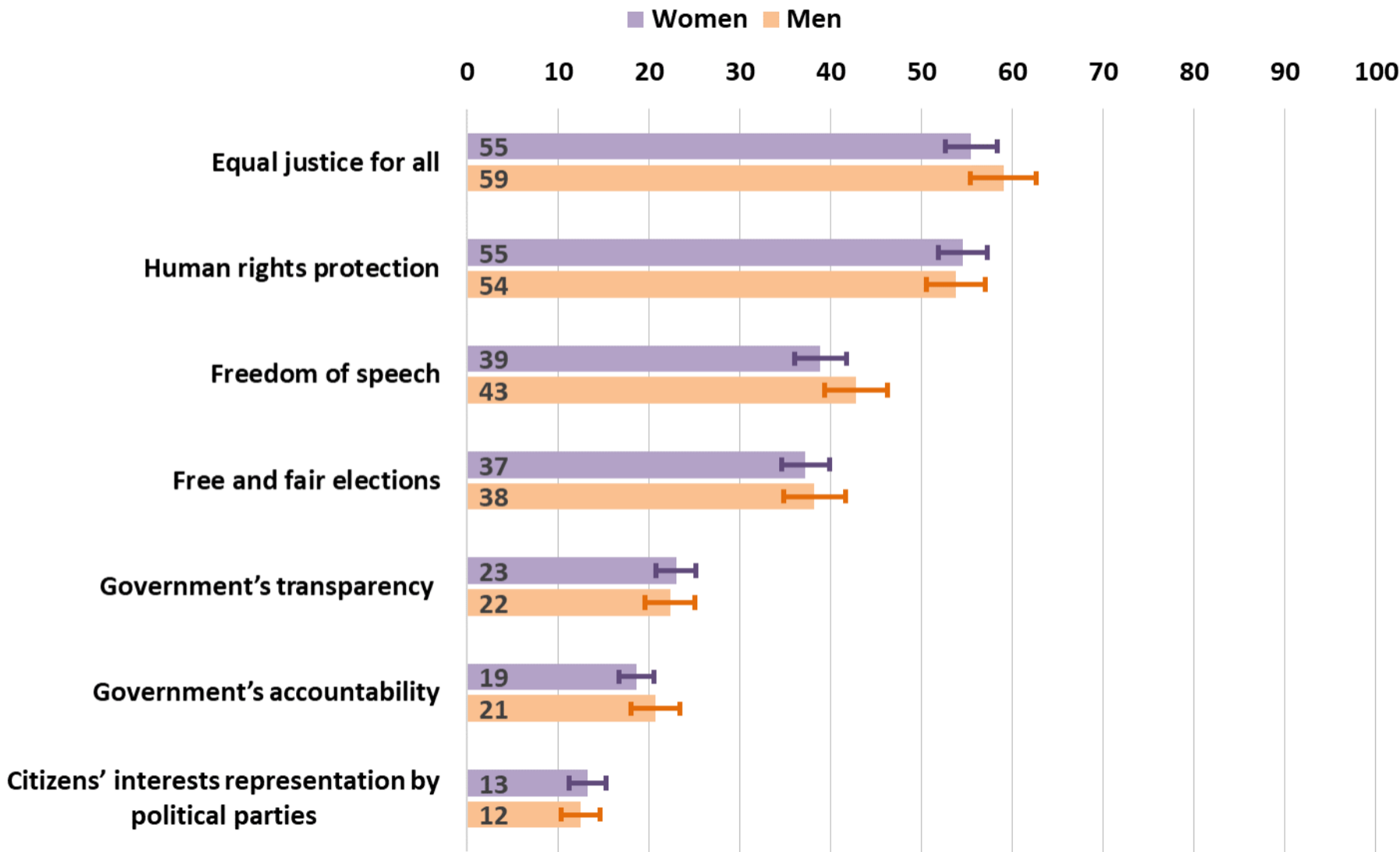

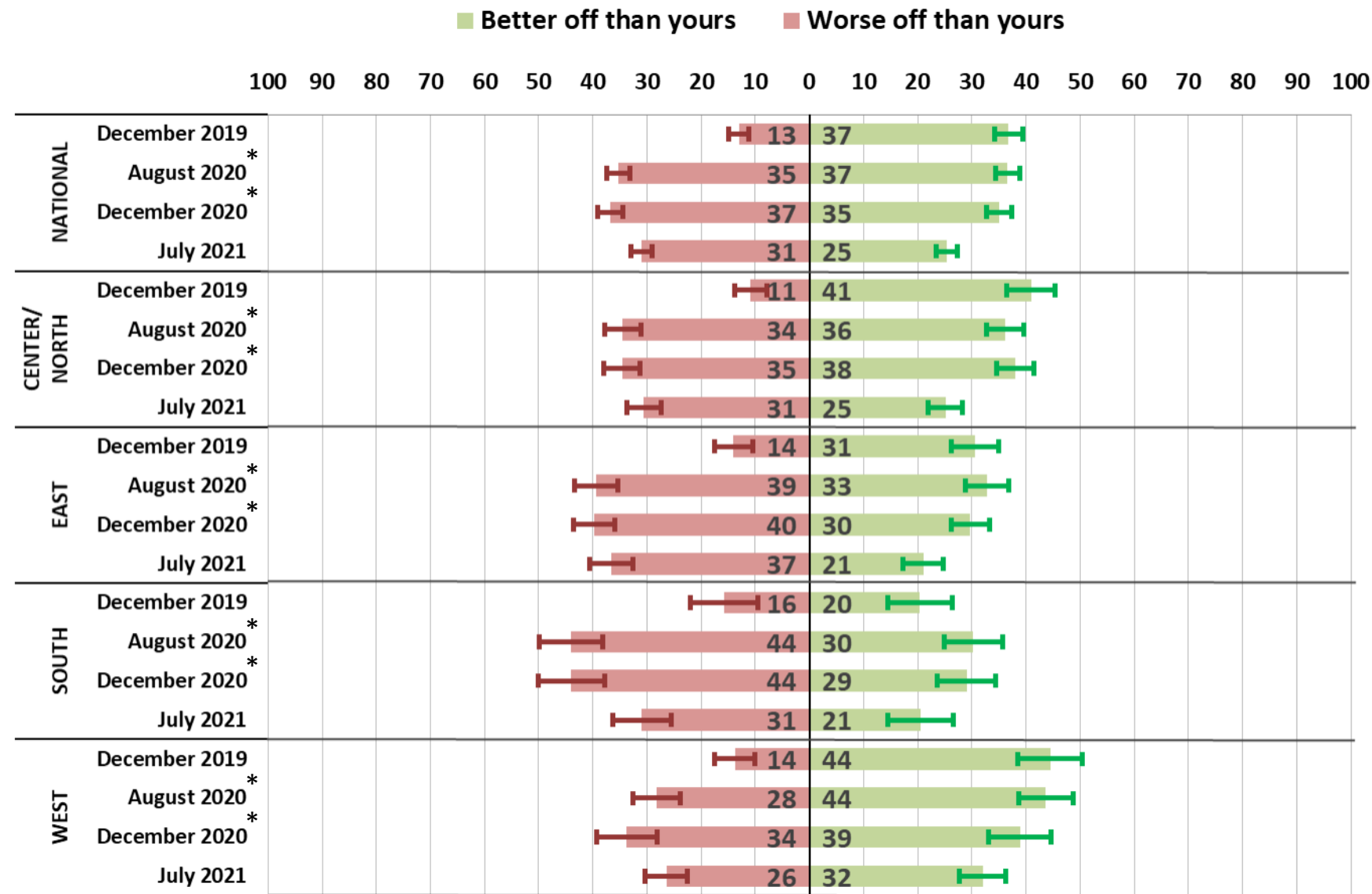


There are many characteristics of a fully functioning democracy. Which three are most important? (q5 X Sex)

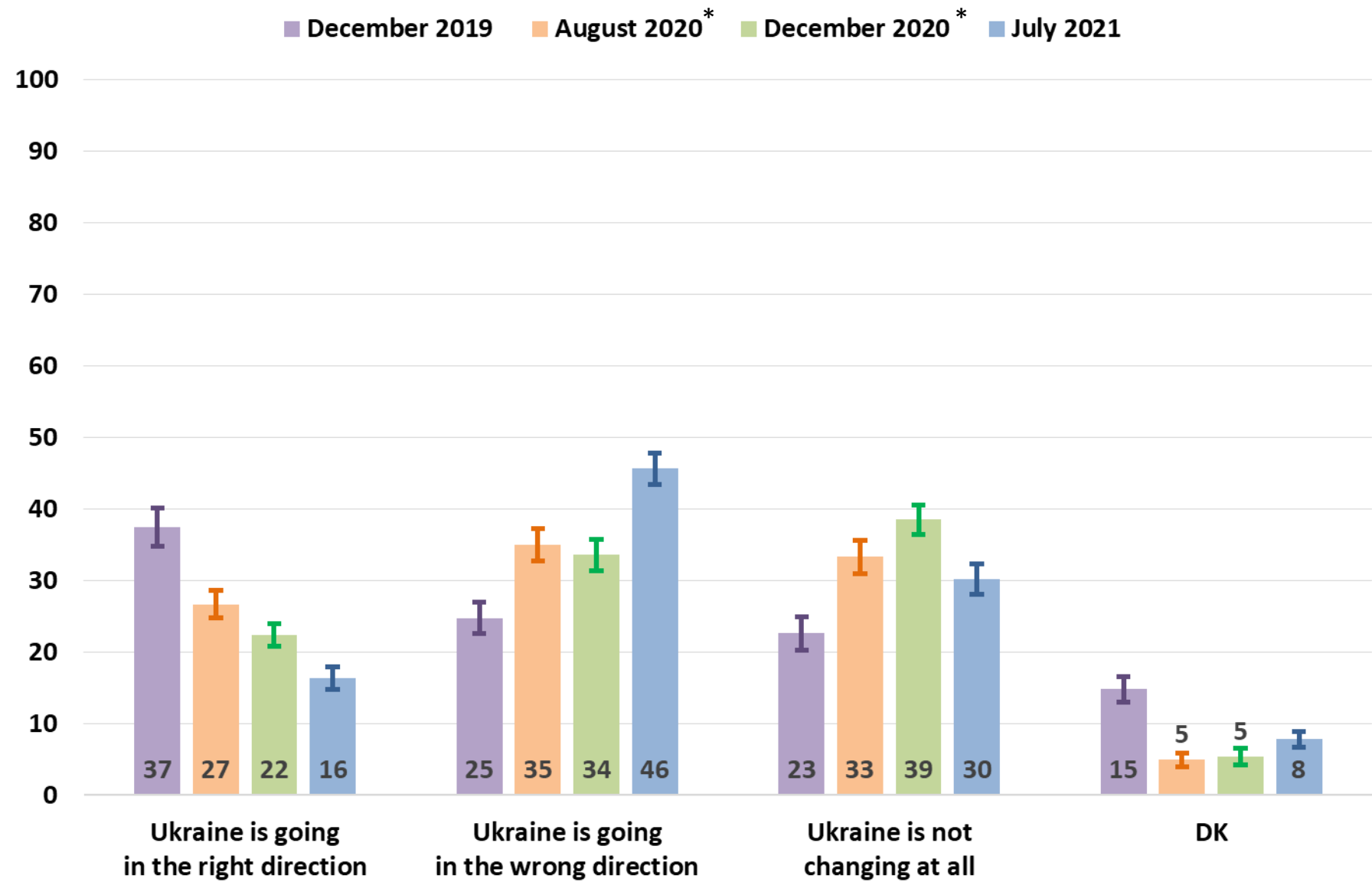

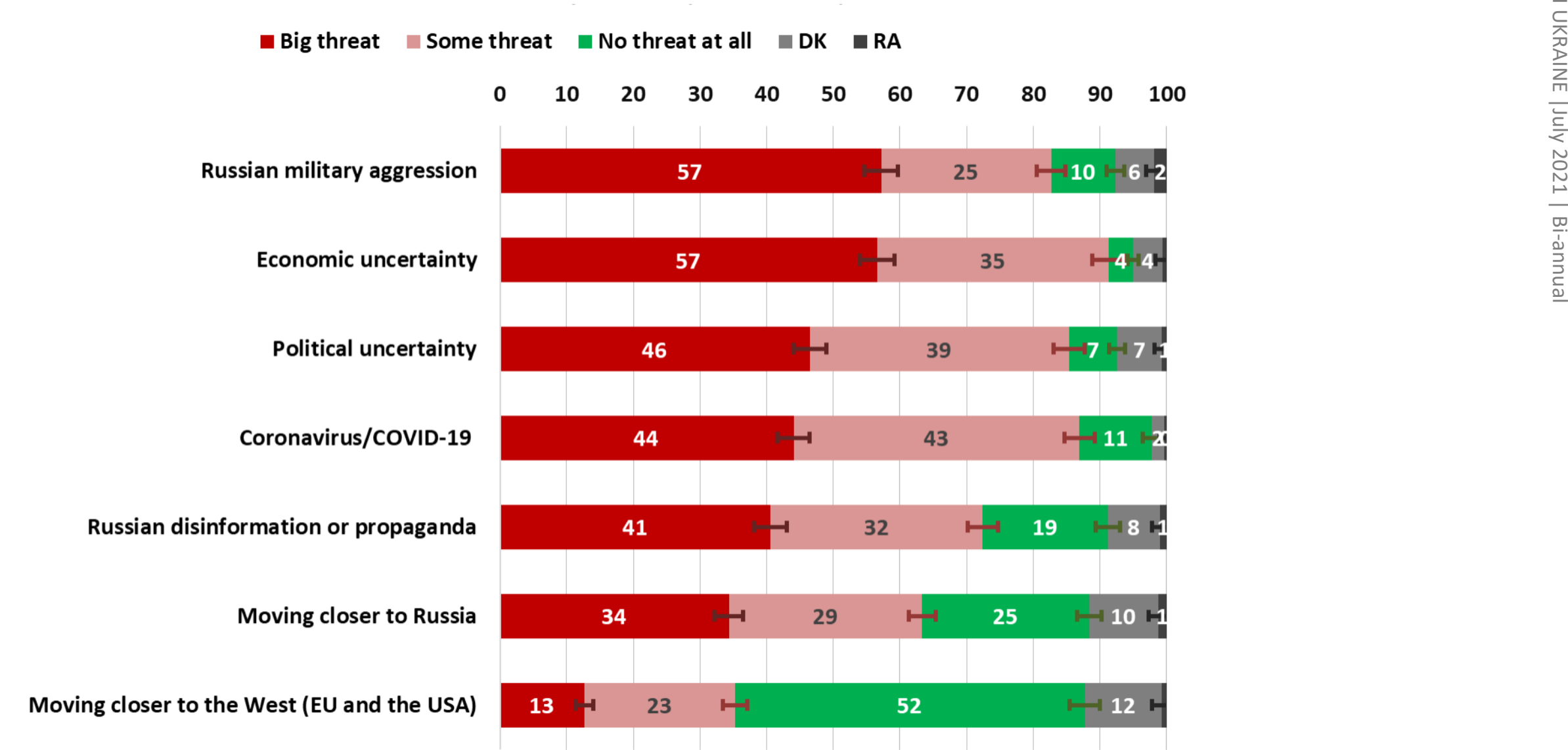

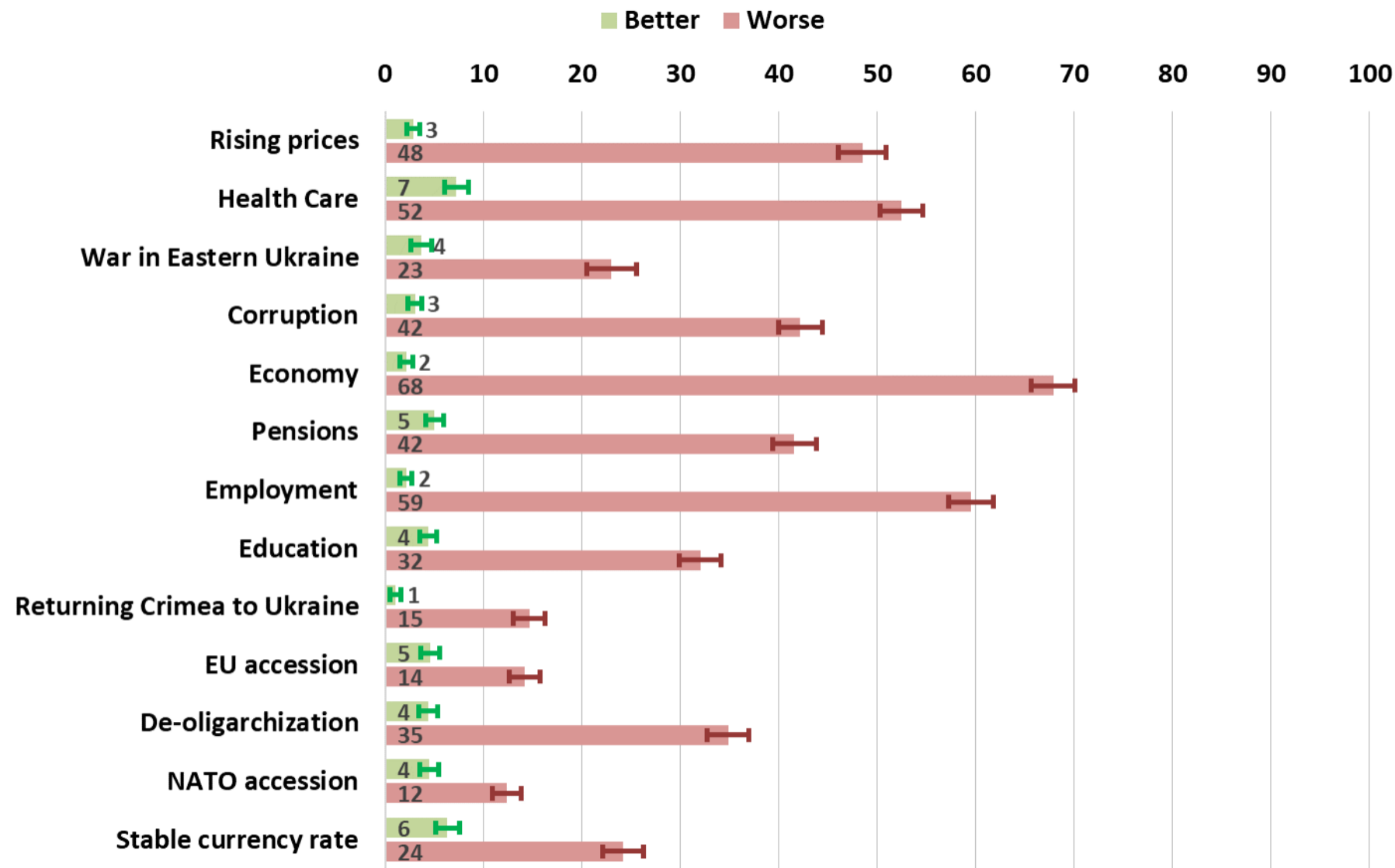

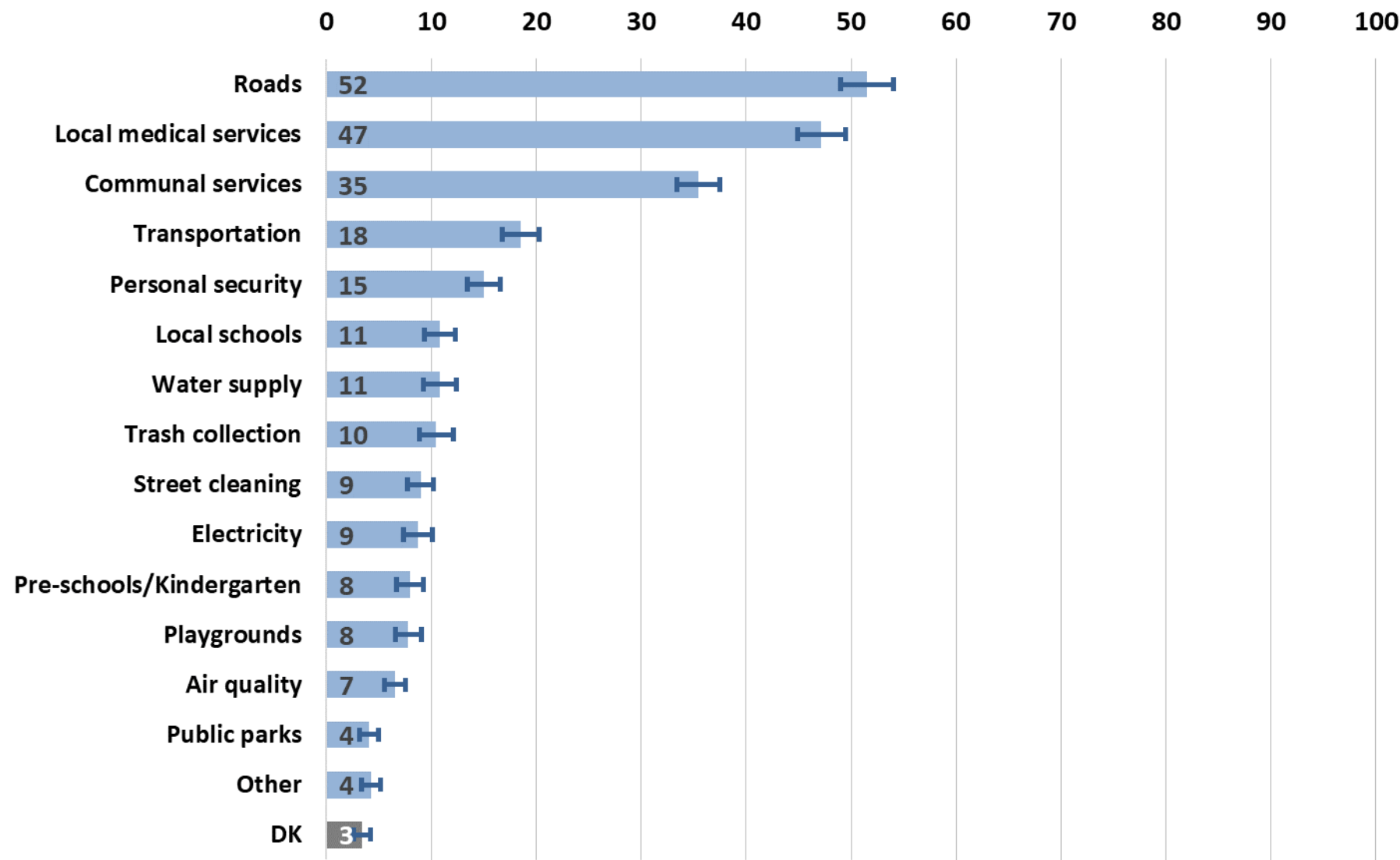
How do you think the situation has changed in Ukraine since the 2019 presidential election? (q2)



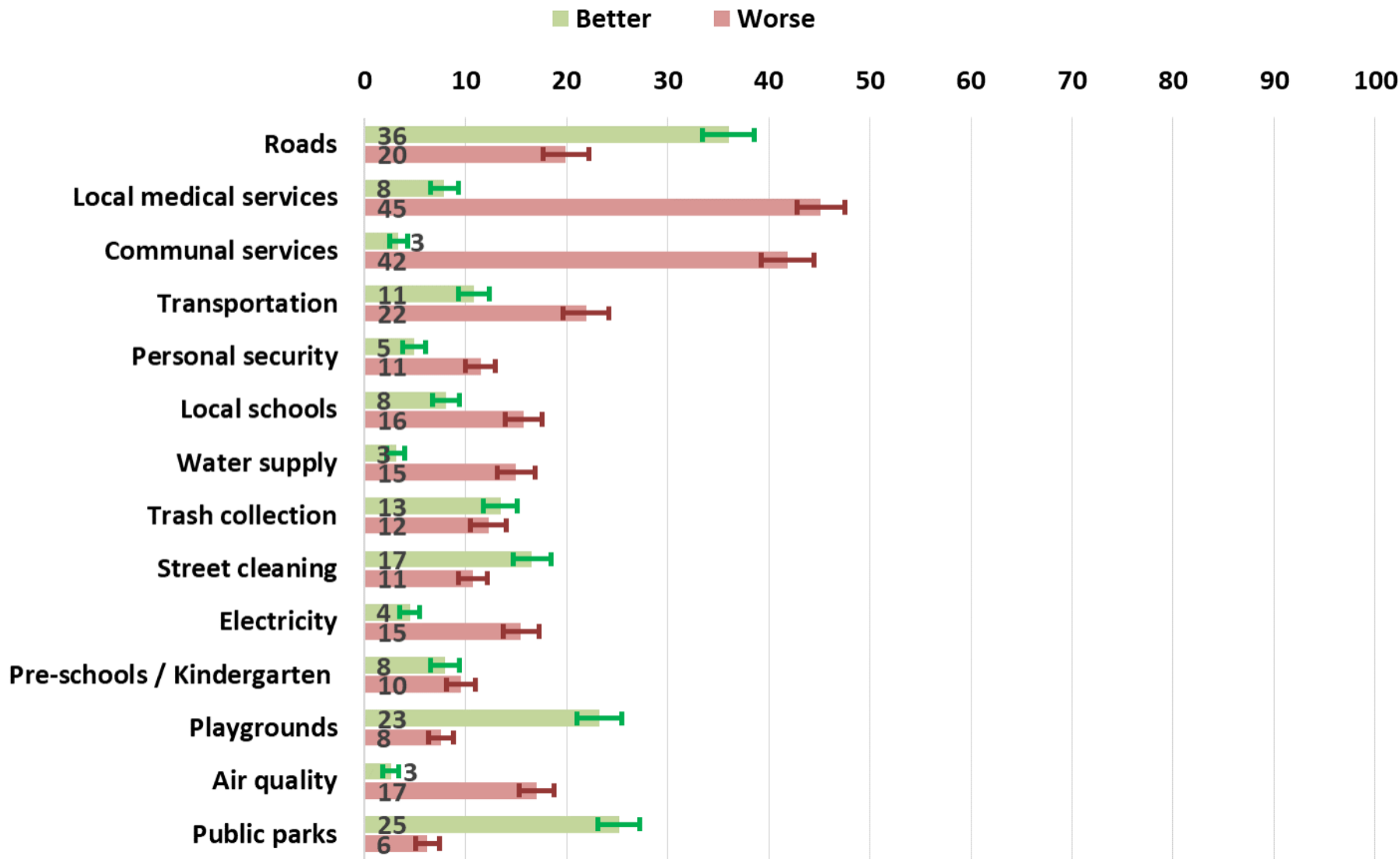


Which local issues are most important for you and your family? (q15)

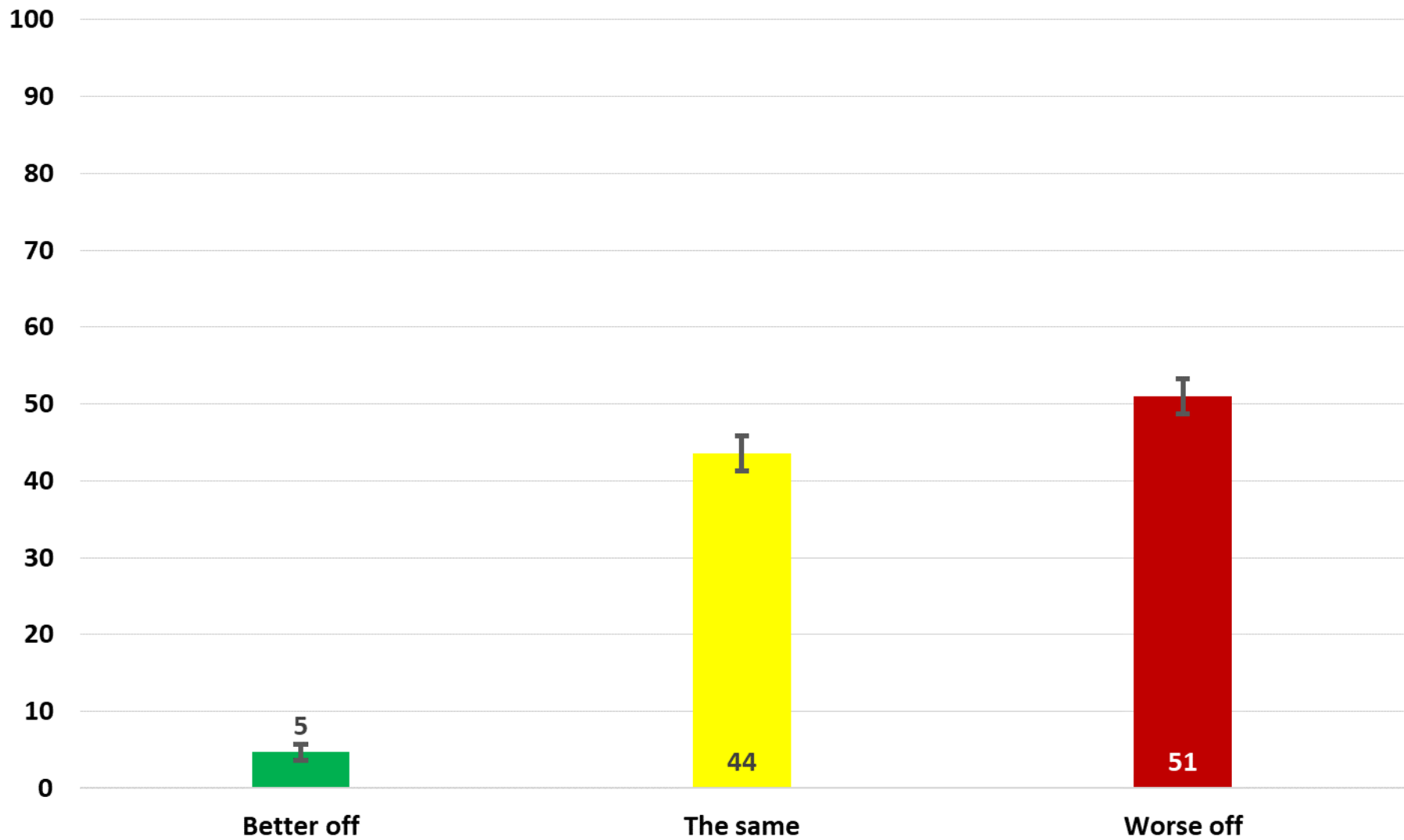

How do you think the situation has changed in Ukraine since the 2020 local elections? (q16)

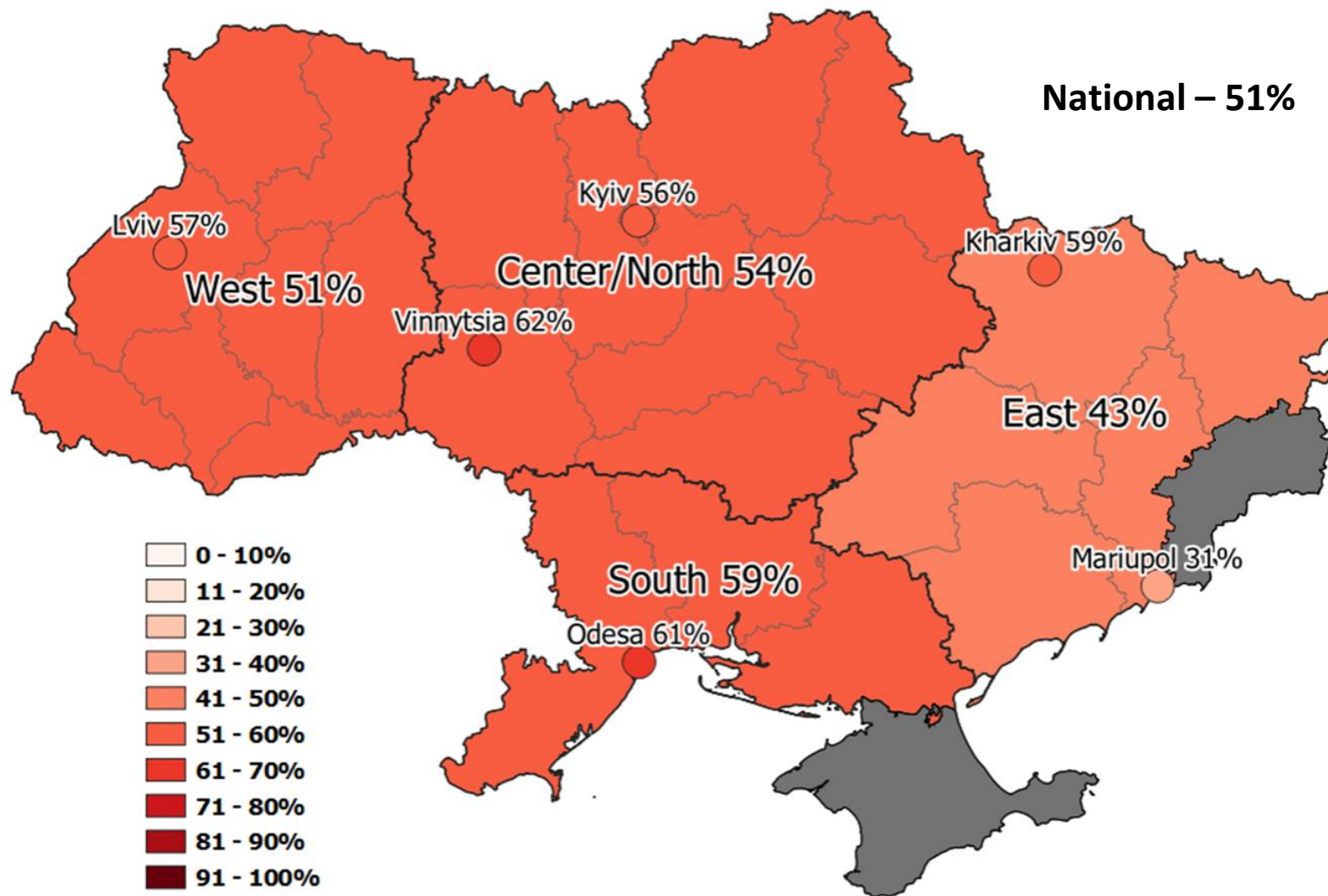


Since the start of the coronavirus outbreak in Ukraine in March 2020, would you say that in economic terms you and your family are...? (q7)



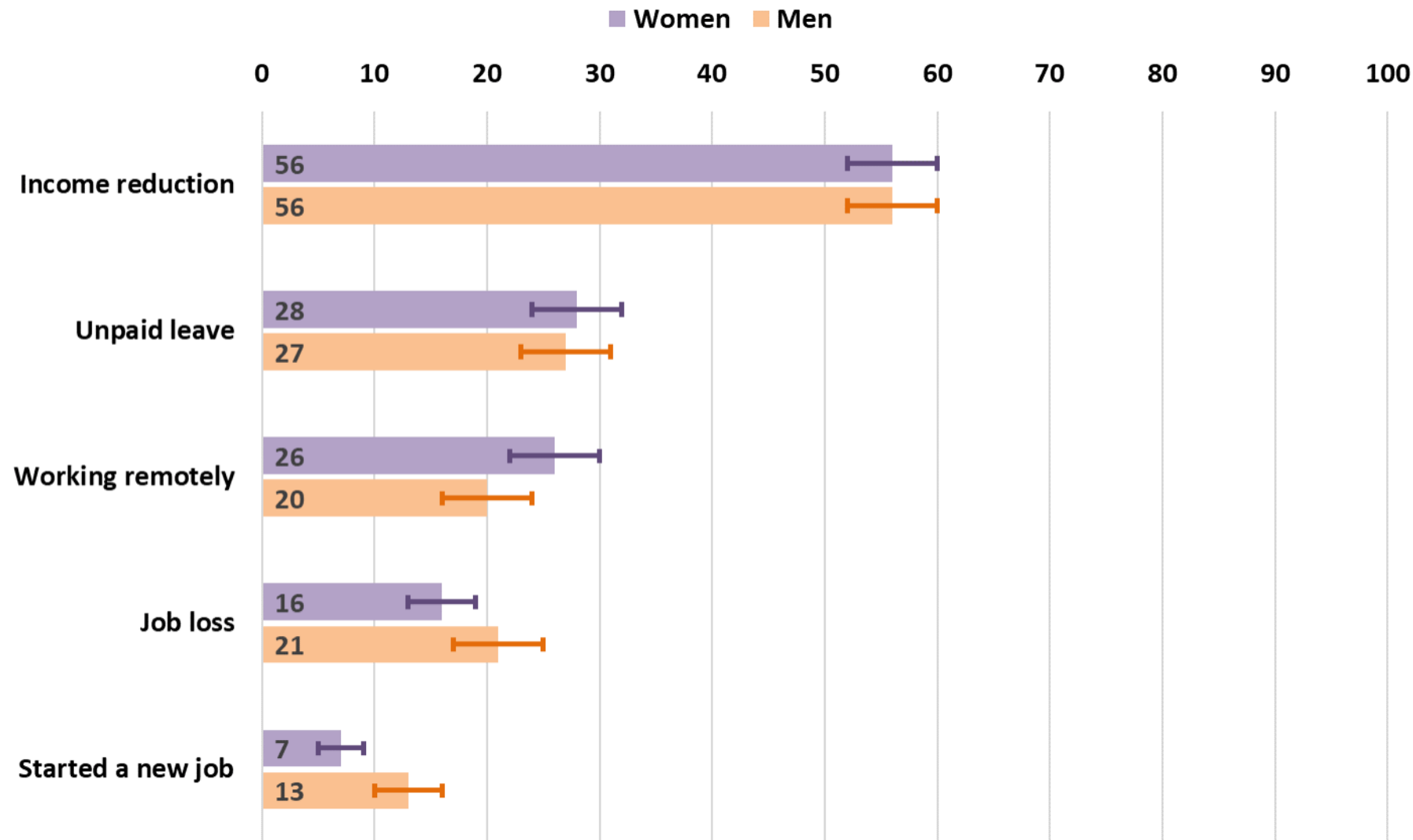

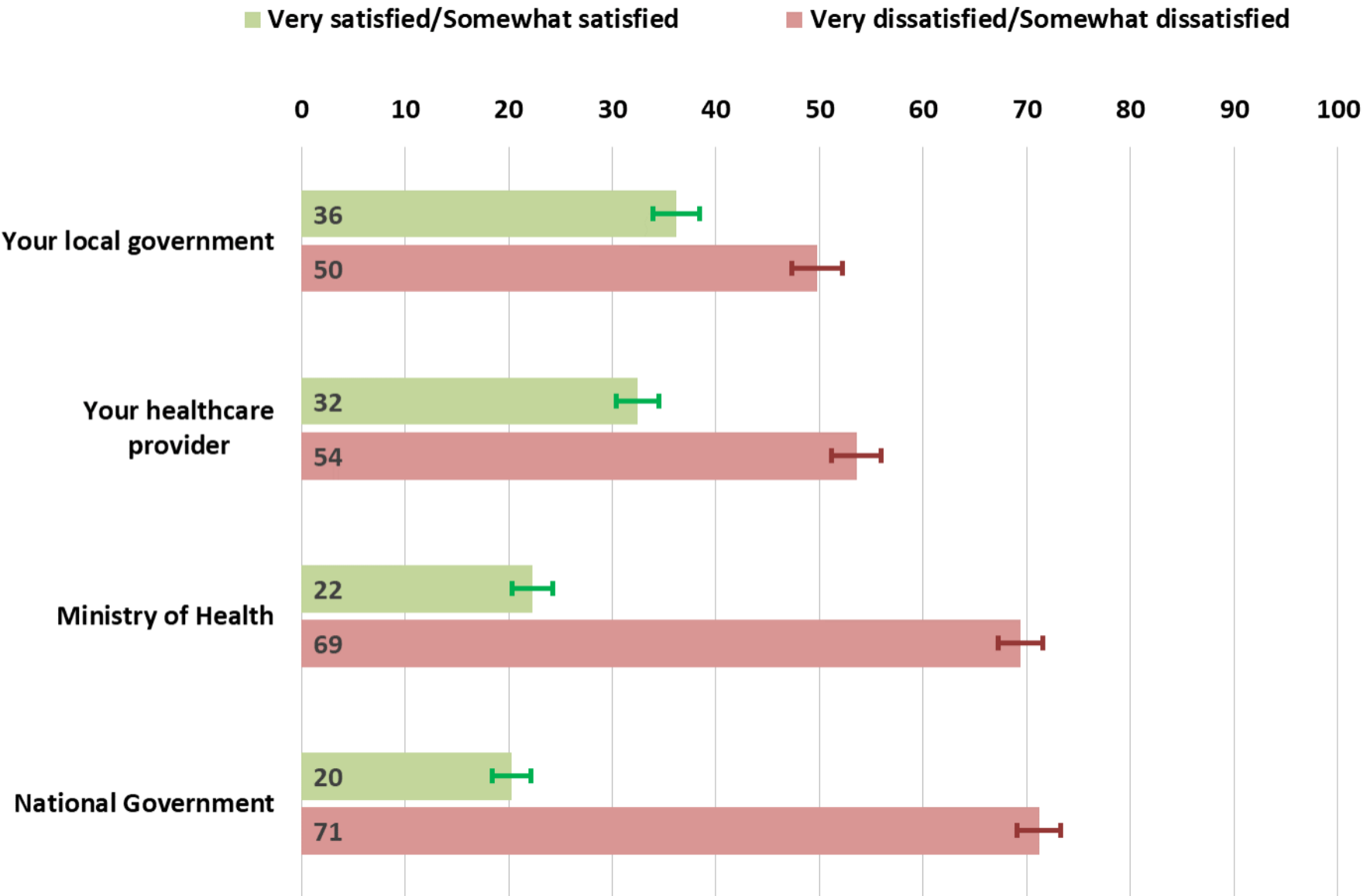


Have you personally faced the following since the start of the coronavirus outbreak in Ukraine? (q60 X q59 X Sex)

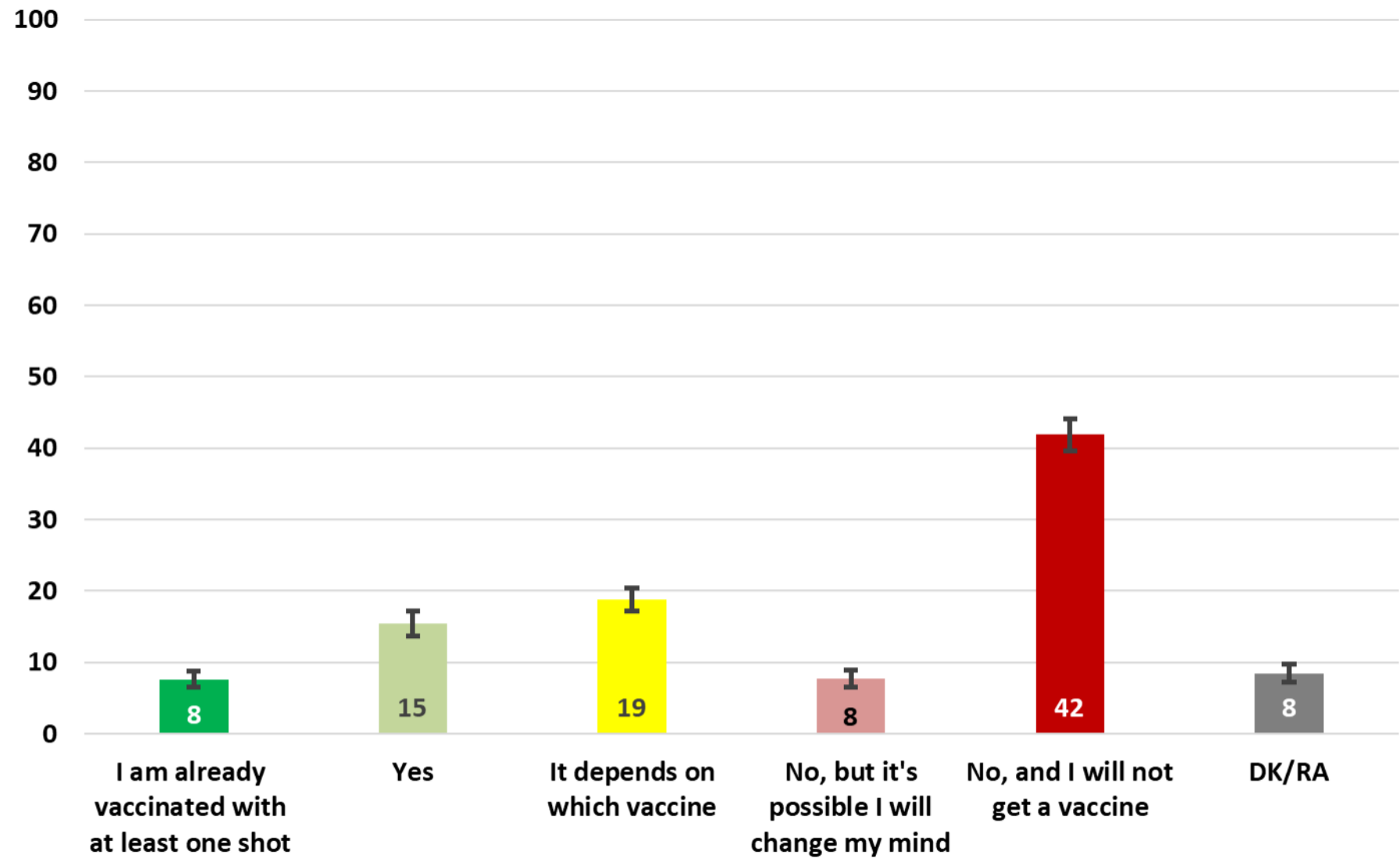

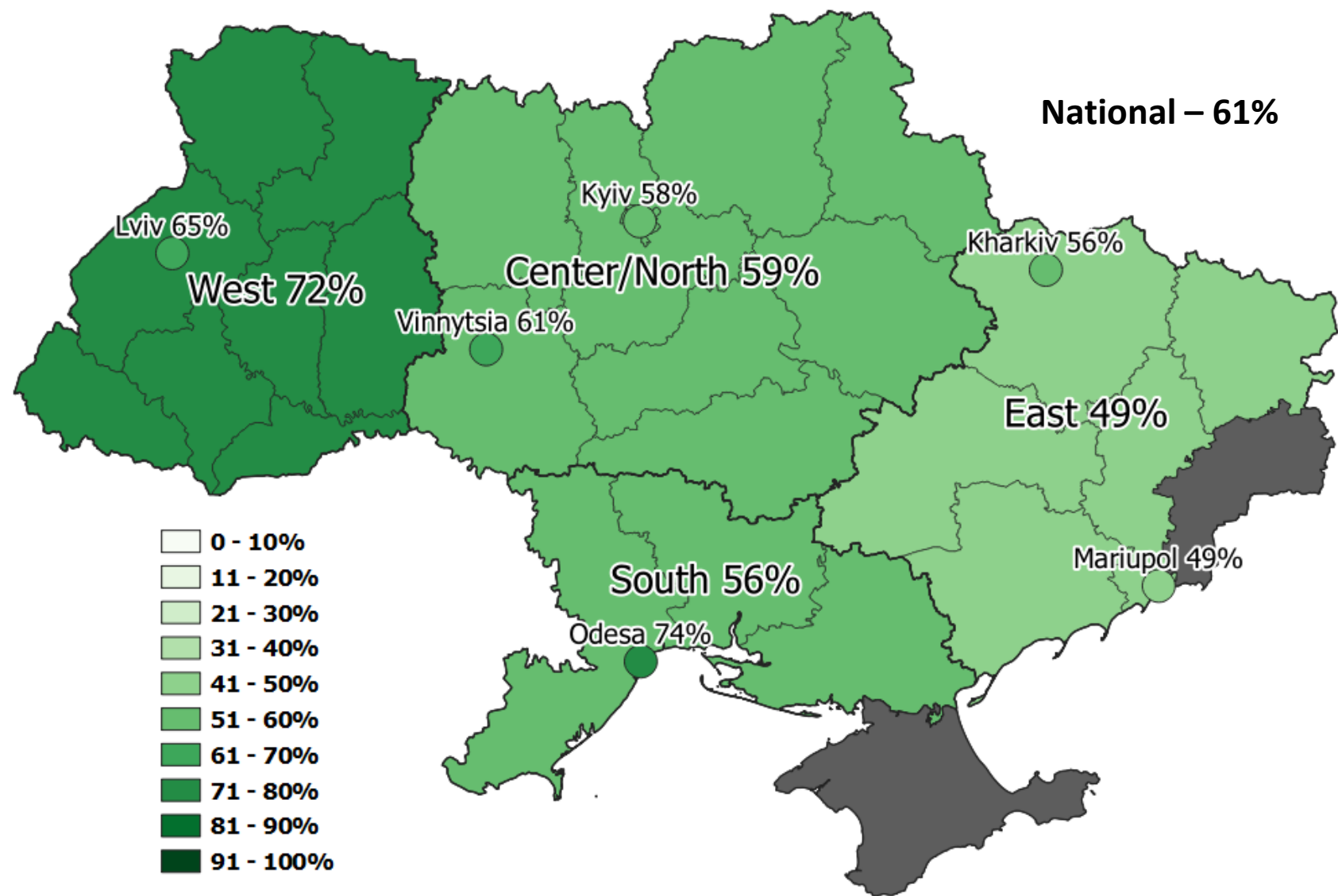

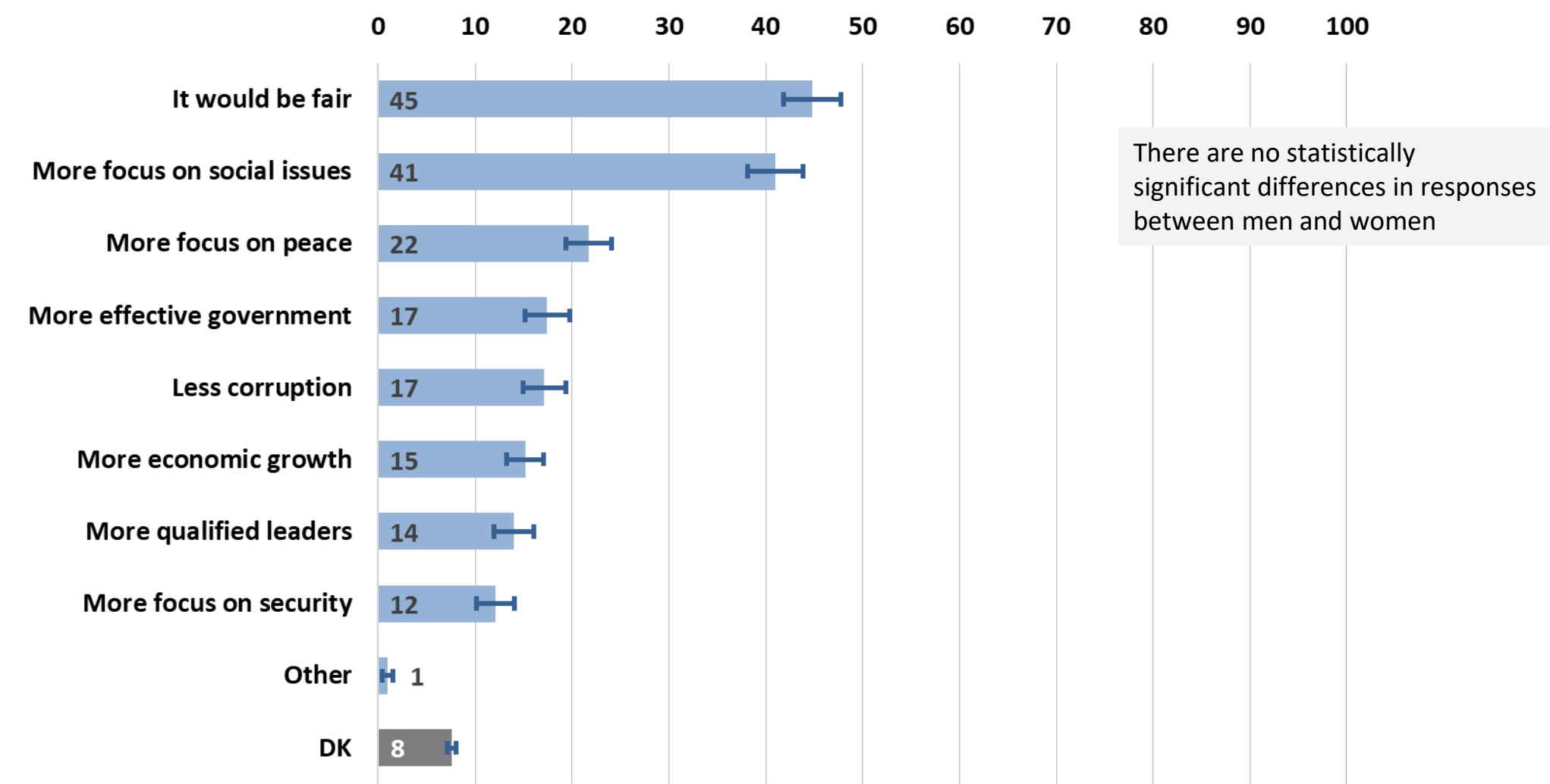
Who should be more involved in political life, men or women? (q18 X Settlement)

Why do you think a better balance of men and women in political life is important? (q19)

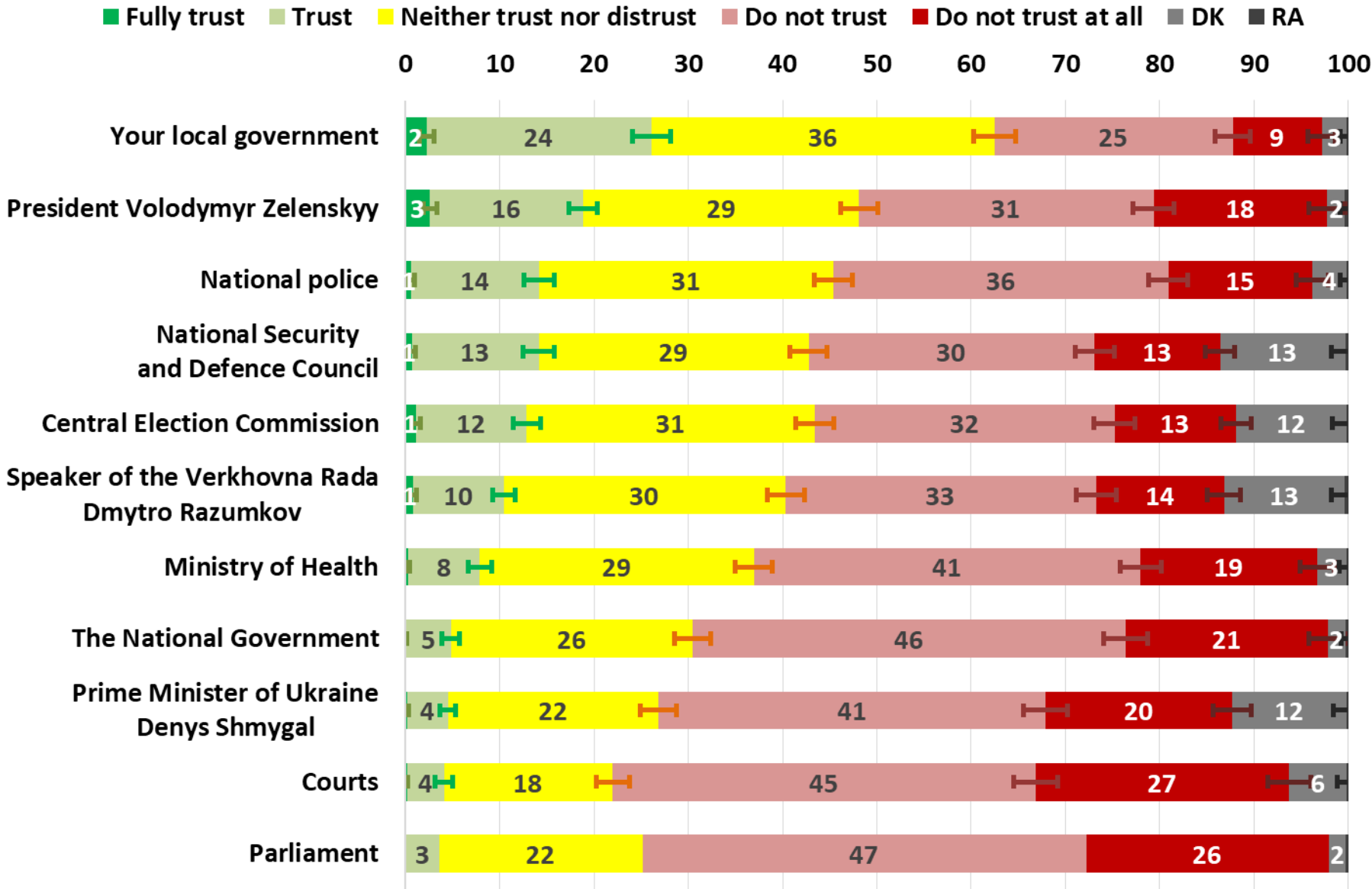

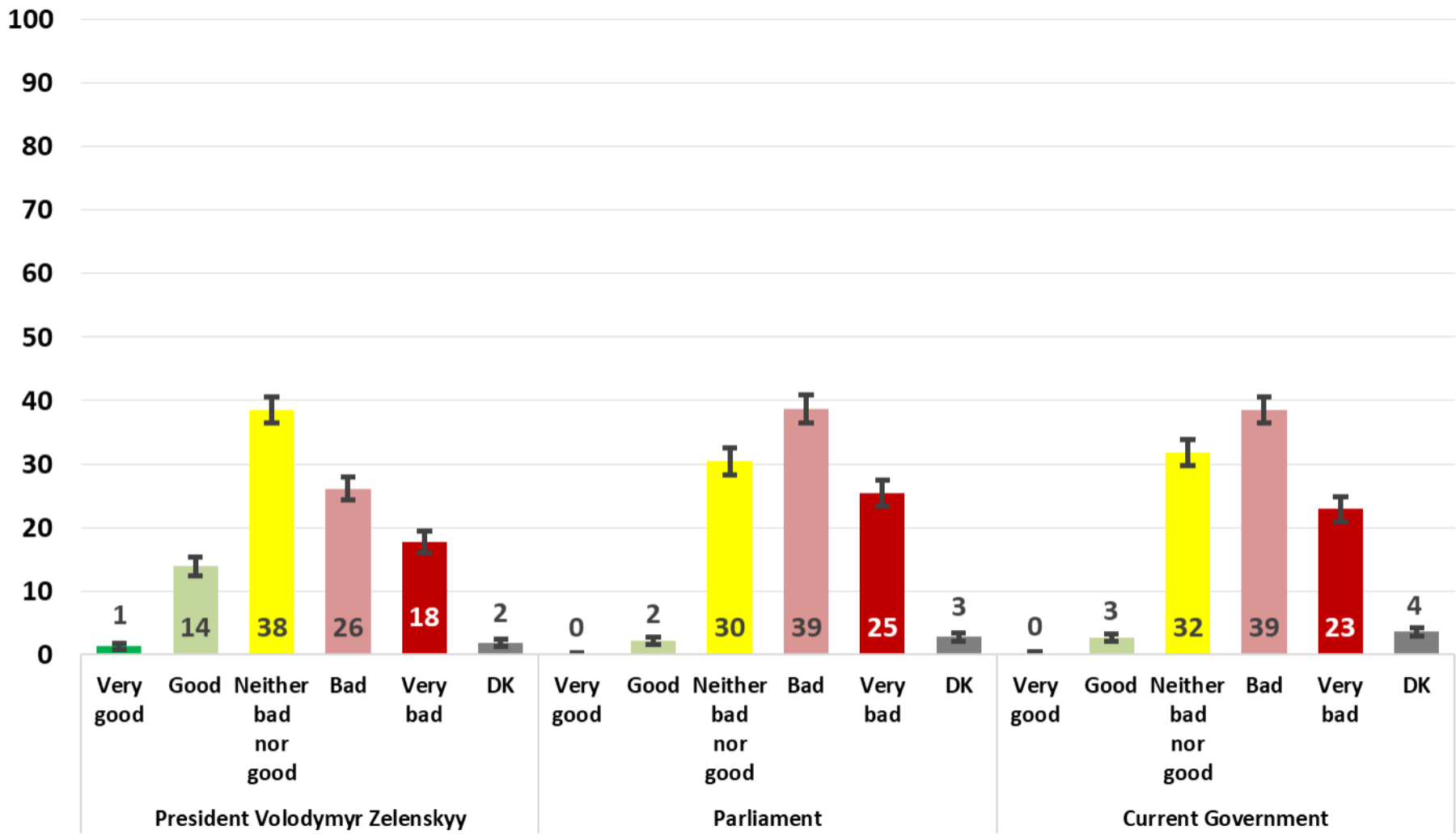

To what extent, if at all, do you trust the following? (q30)

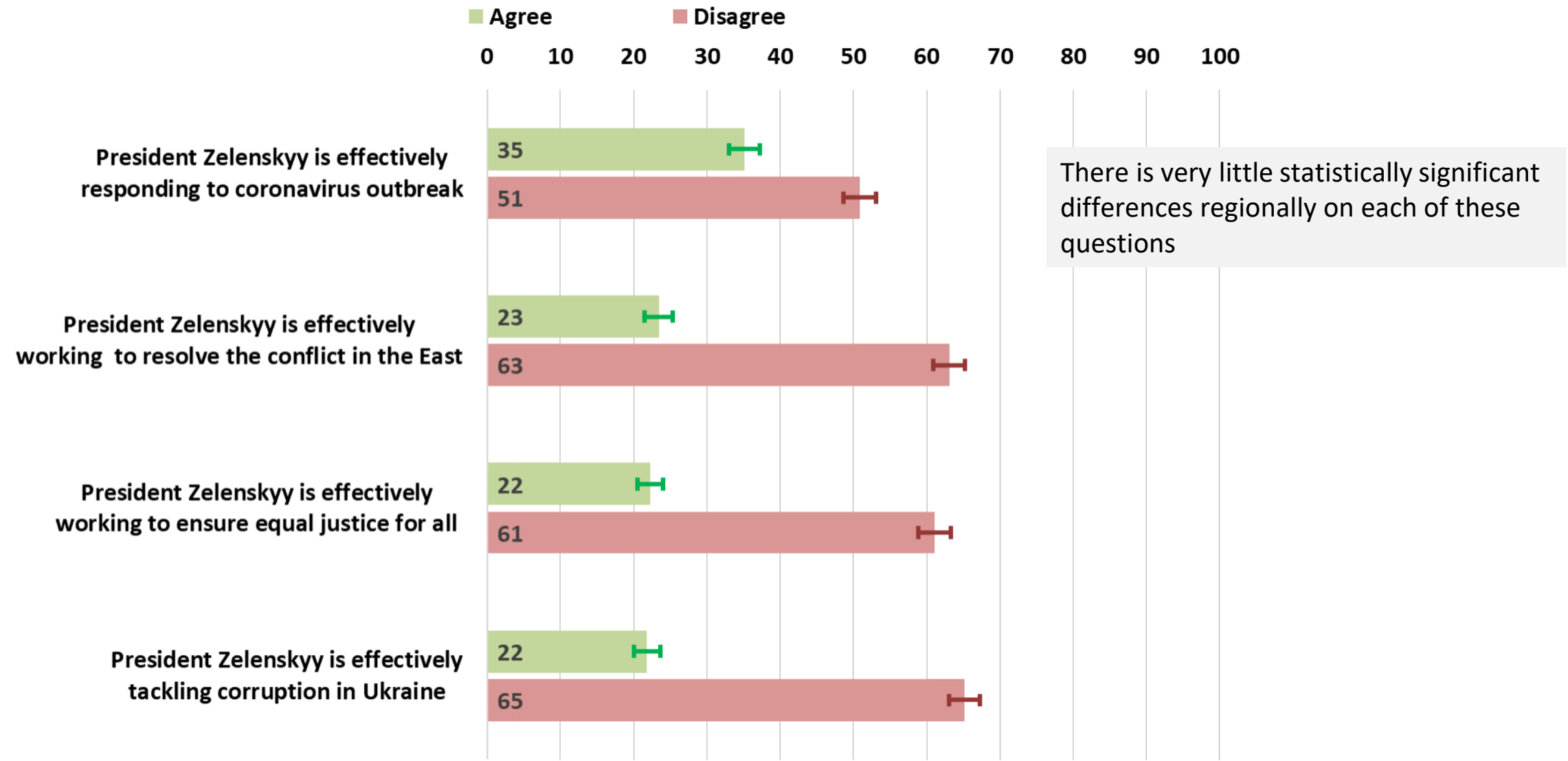


How would you rate President's / Parliament's / Current Government's performance so far? (q21, 24, 25)

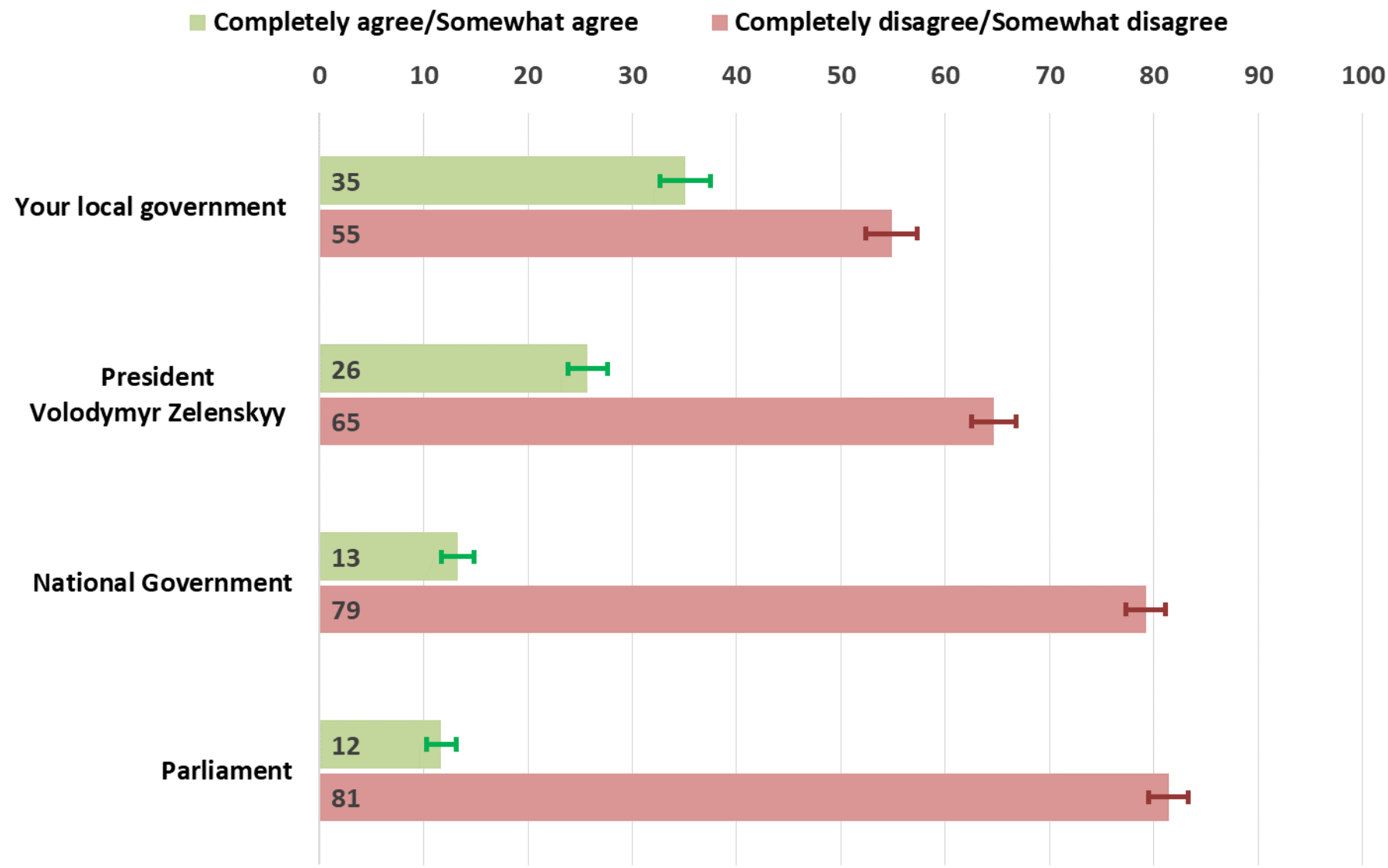




How much do you agree or disagree with the following statements? (q22)

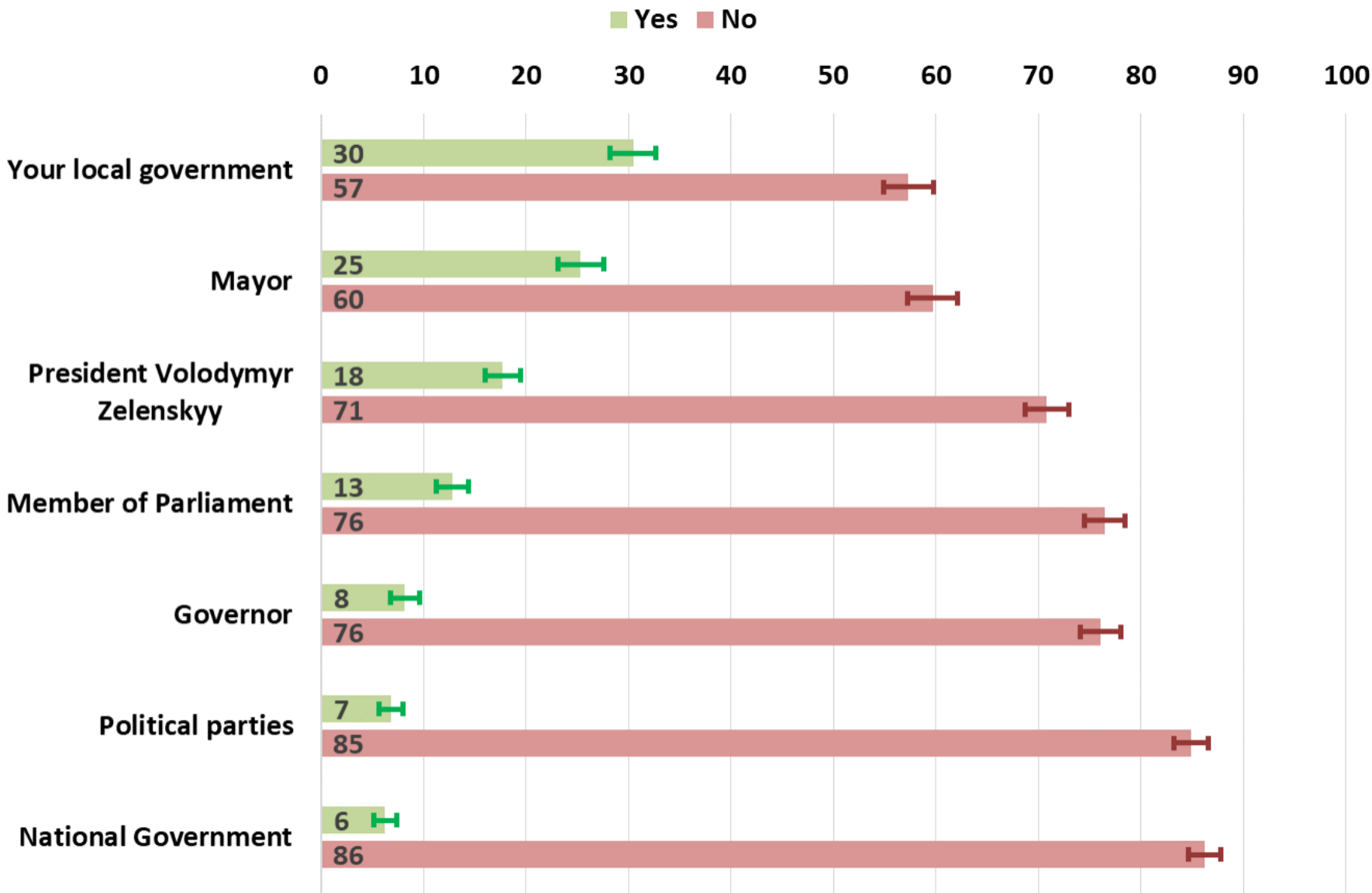


To what extent do you agree or disagree that the following will make changes that matter to you (q26)

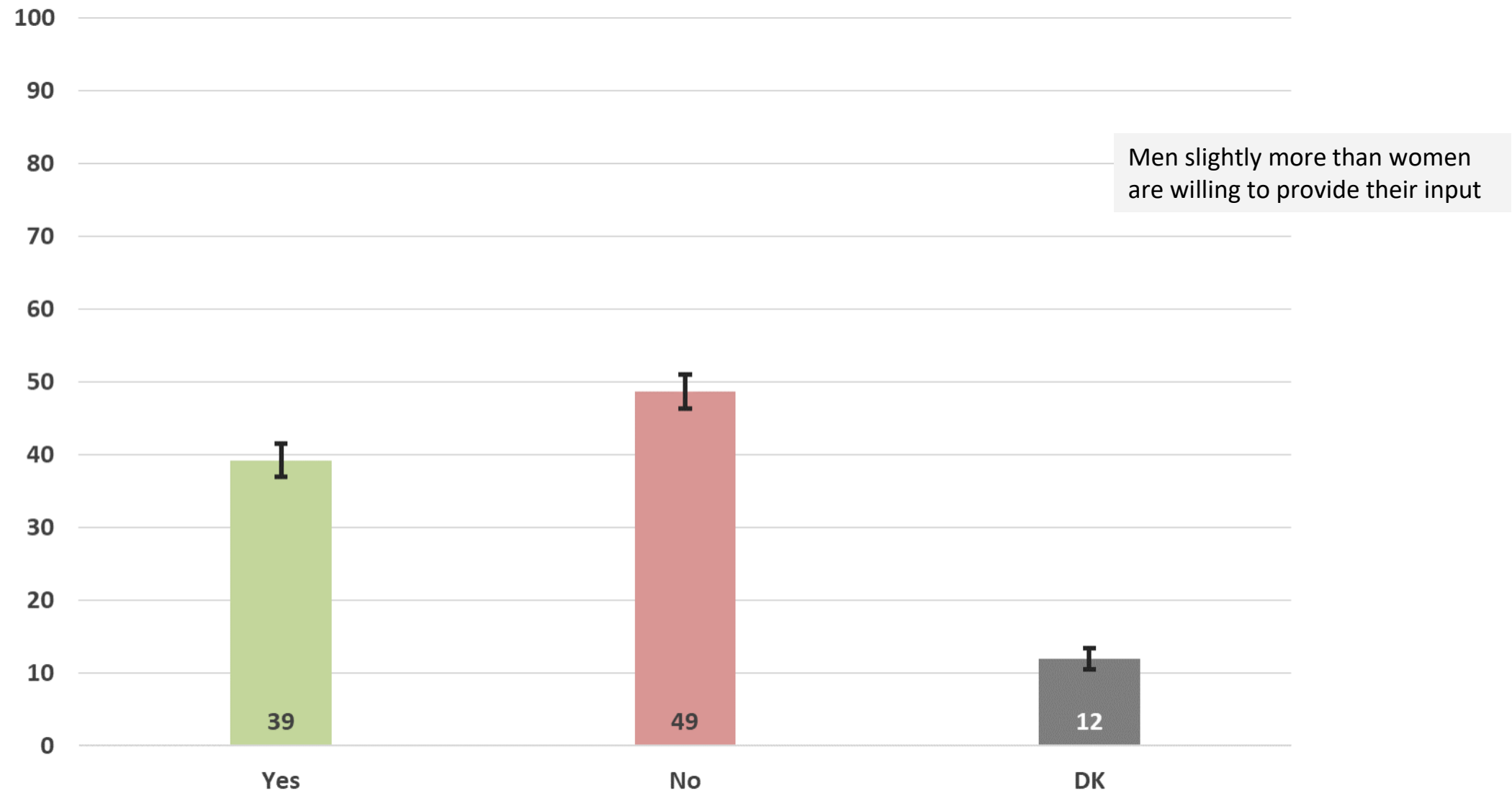

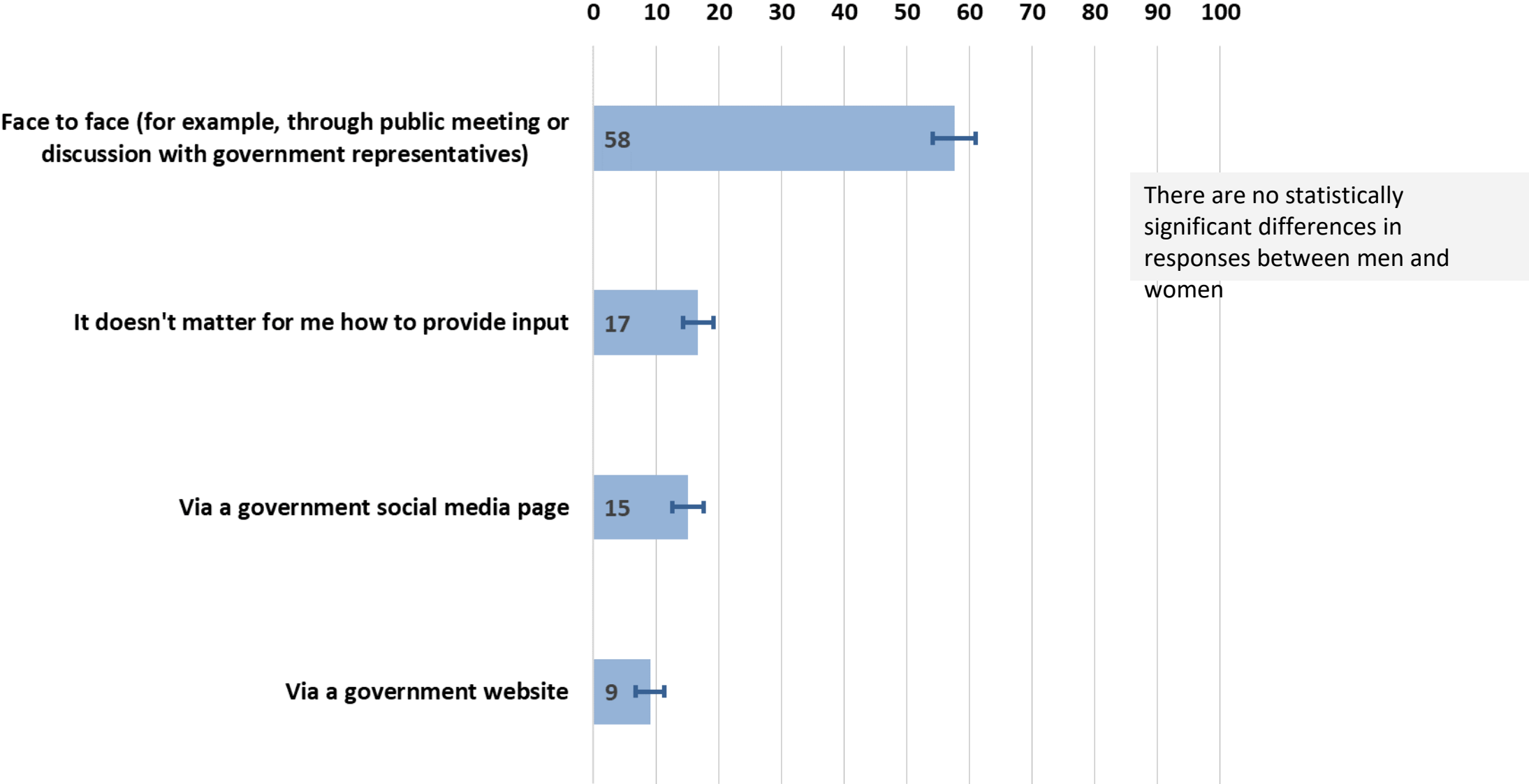


If the government were interested in hearing your opinion on an issue that matters to you, would you be willing to provide your input? (q13)

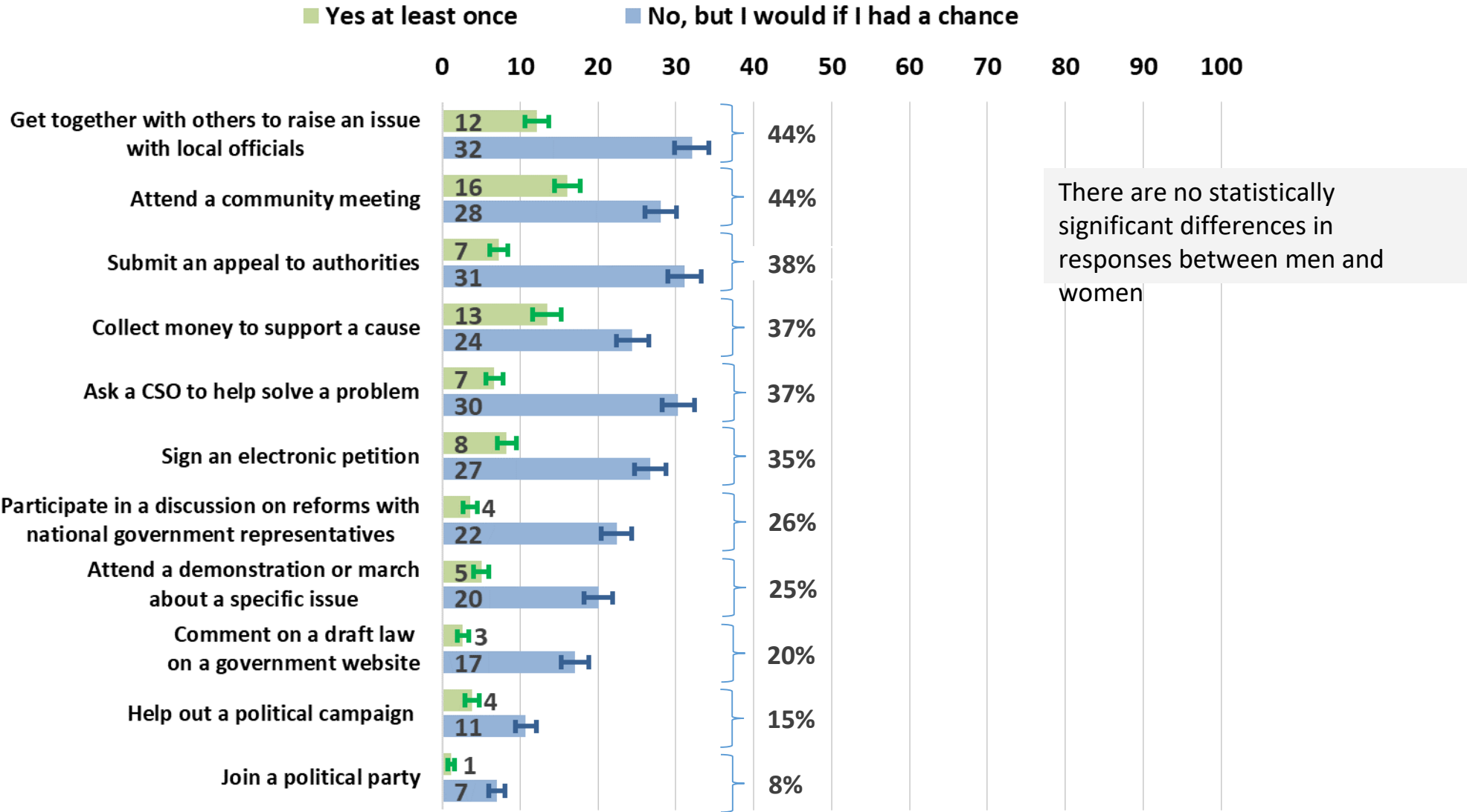




What would be the most convenient way for you to provide your input? (q14)

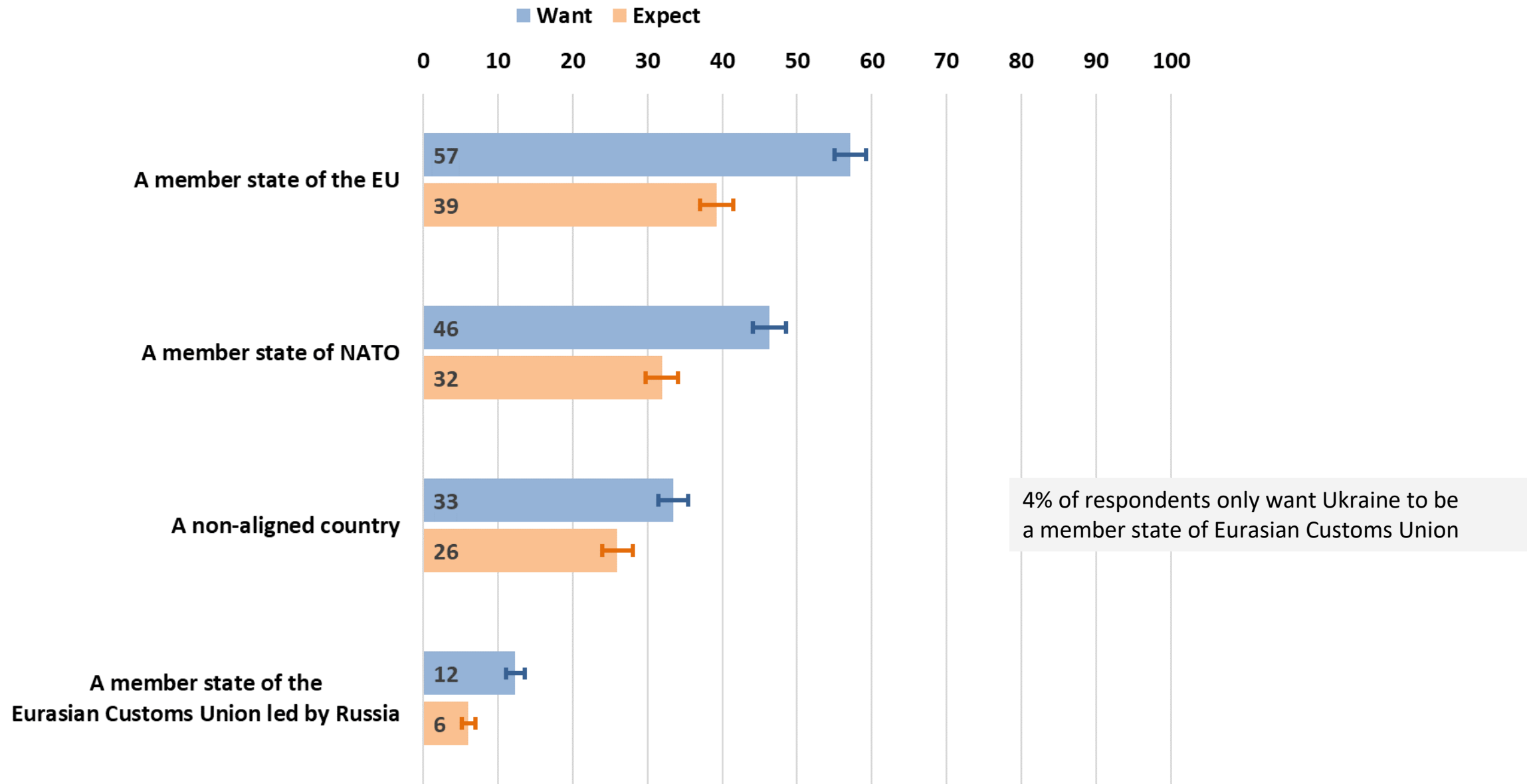


Here is a list of actions citizens can take when they want to change something.
Have you done any of these within the last 12 months? (q12)



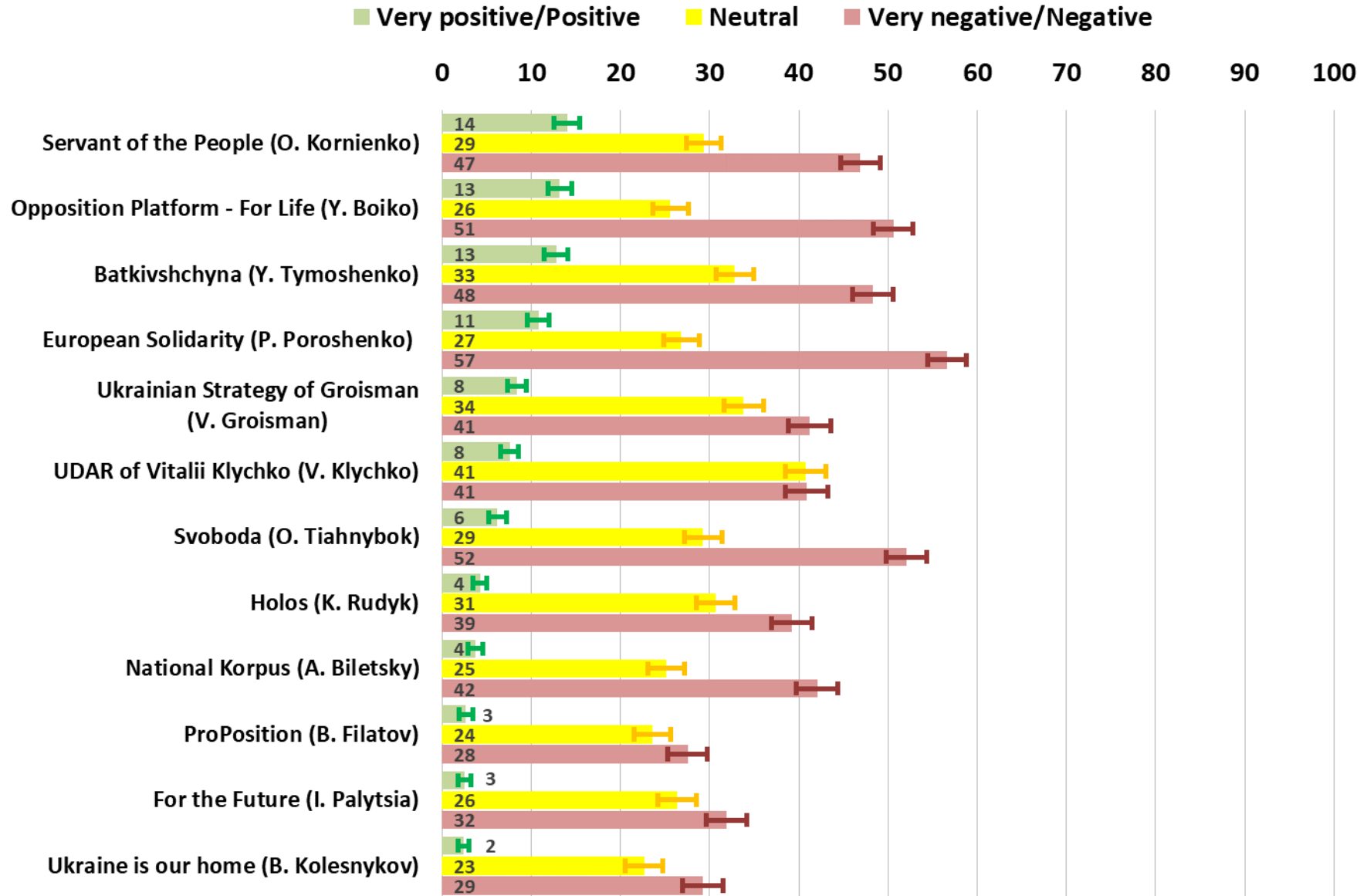


By 2030, do you want/expect Ukraine to be... (q42/q43)

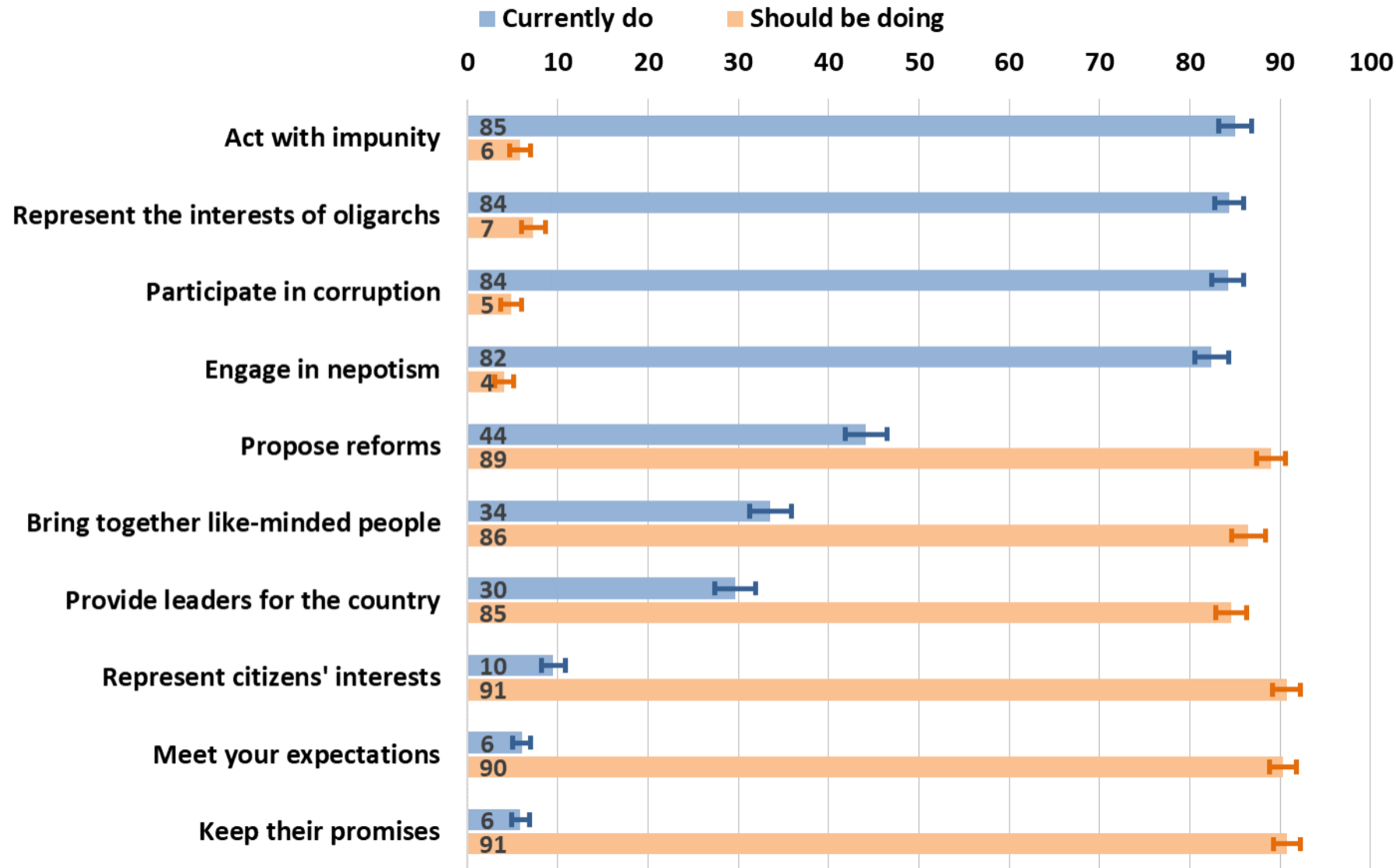

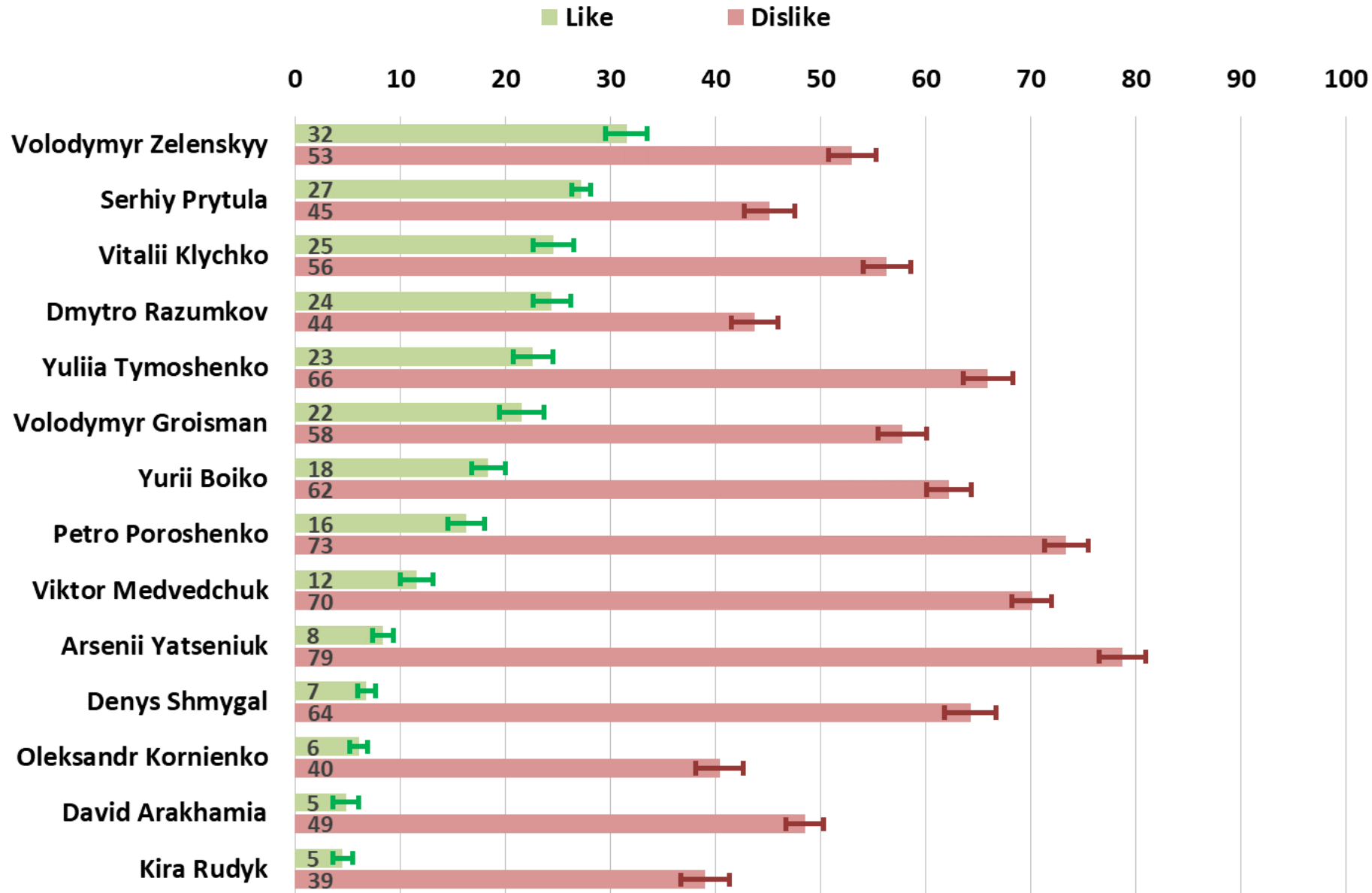
What is your attitude towards the following parties today? (q31)



Do political parties currently do / should be doing any of the following? (q39/q40)



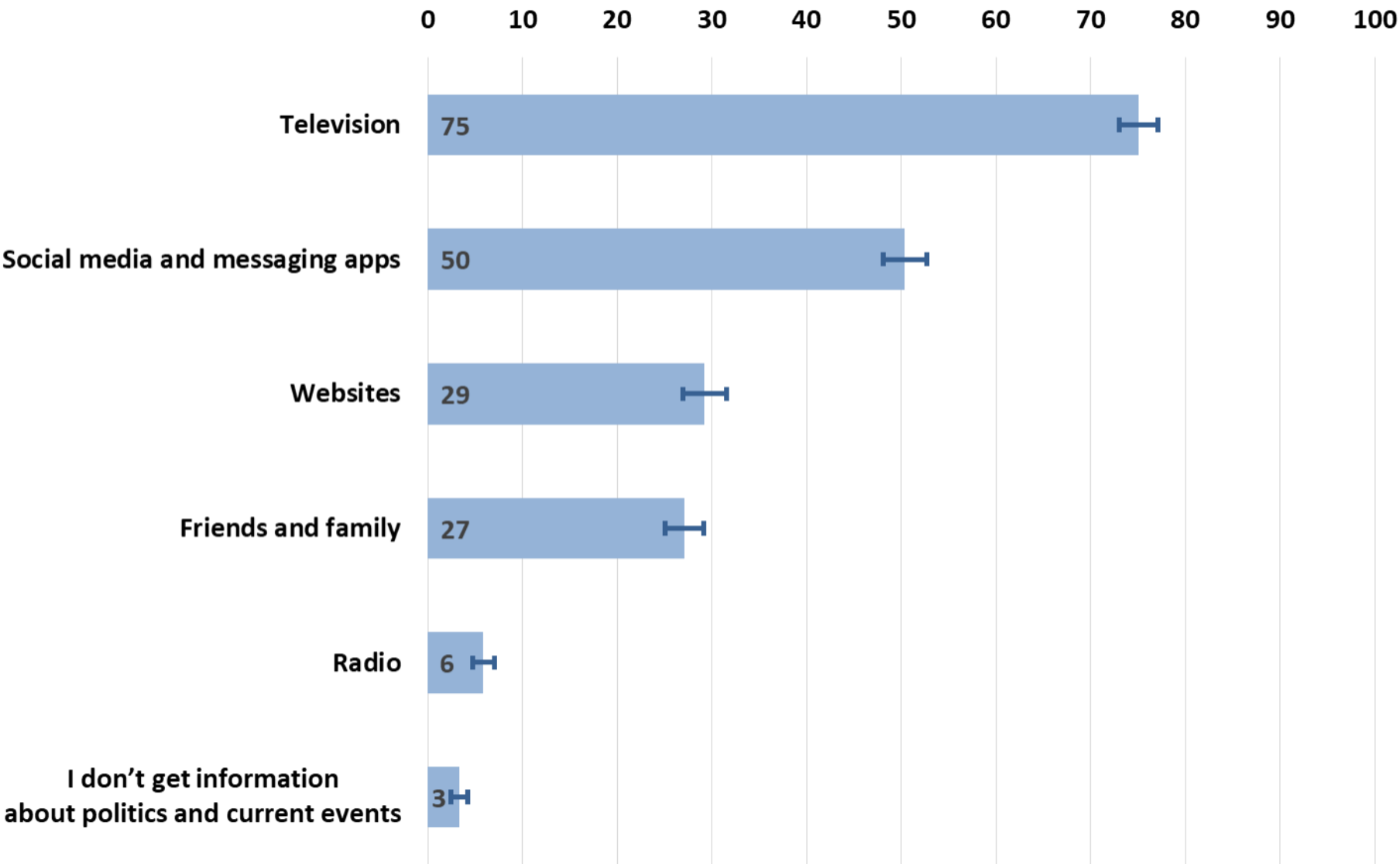

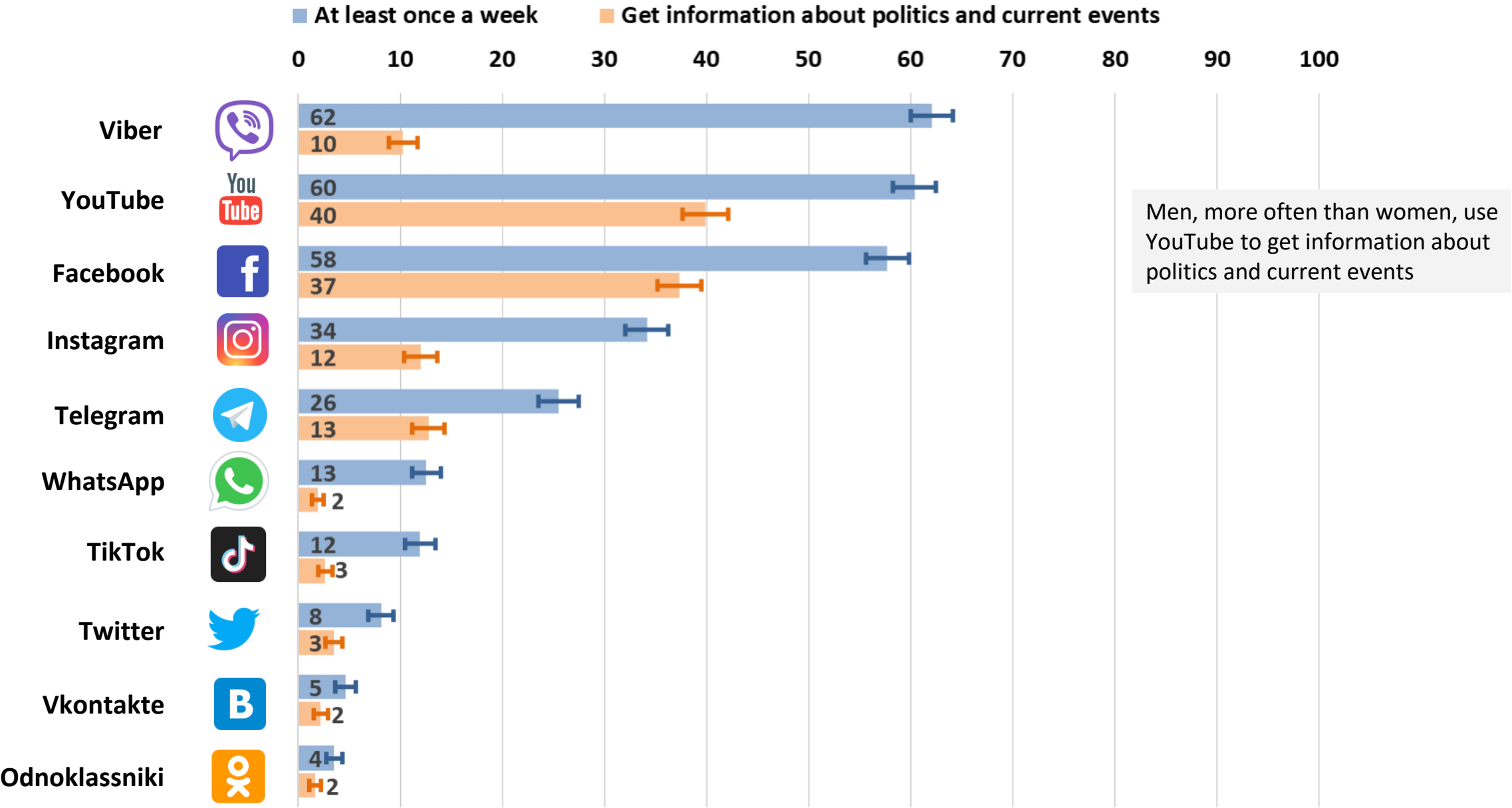

METHODOLOGY

Bi-annual Survey Methodology

Fieldwork dates: July 1 – August 3, 2021

6,097 completed interviews

The nationally representative sample was random at all stages:

- Random selection of election precincts
- Random selection of households via random route sampling
- Random selection of respondents within the households using modified Kish grid

Areas outside the control of the Ukrainian government were excluded

Six oversamples

Kyiv city [600]
Vinnytsia [600]
Kharkiv city [600]
Mariupol city [600]
Odesa city [600]
Lviv city [600]

Quality control

- All interviewers received a three level training system which includes 16 hours of training
- An independent network of controllers conducted quality control interviews
- 30% of all interviews were checked by controllers
- All 6,097 interviews were conducted using tablets

The margin of error for national sample is 2.7%

- Margin of error for oversamples does not exceed 6%

The margin of error is different for every response to every question in all surveys. In this presentation, the margin of error is shown for each question/option

- This is shown in the example below:
 - A is statistically greater than B and C
 - There is no statistical difference between B and C
