To foster the development of more responsive policies and governance;

To help stakeholders diagnose and address issues of public concern.

- Leaders from across the political spectrum have reported that polls are important to their work and encourage continued polling;
- Inclusive process: the polling instrument was developed in consultation with political parties, government, and civil society leaders.

ABOUT THE POLL

- Fieldwork dates: July 13-29, 2019
- 2,131 completed interviews (41% response rate)
- The average margin of error is +/- 1.7%
- Note: the margin of error is different for every response

SAMPLE

- A nationally representative sample (excluding occupied territories) including oversampled areas of the <u>Capital</u>, <u>Large</u> <u>Urban</u>, <u>Small Urban</u>, <u>Rural</u> and <u>Minority</u> Settlements
- Large Urban stratum consists of cities with a population 40K or more: Batumi, Zugdidi, Rustavi, Poti, Gori, and Kutaisi
- Small Urban stratum consists of the rest of the cities/dabas holding urban status, and
- Minority stratum consists of settlements, where ethnic minorities (mostly Armenians & Azerbaijani) compose at least 40% of the voters in given settlement. Settlements within this stratum are dispersed throughout Kvemo Kartli, Samtskhe-Javakheti & Kakheti regions.

METHODOLOGY

We use random sampling at all stages. We use a complex survey design:

- Stratification dividing population in relatively homogenous sub-groups; and
- Clustering randomly selecting small geographic areas for each sub-group (stratum).
- Households are selected via random route sampling;
- Respondents are selected using a Kish table;
- Randomly selected households and individuals are not substituted; and
- All interviews were conducted face-to-face with 18+ population, using tablets, in Georgian, Armenian, and Azeri.

Main findings

- Perception of country direction at its worst in a decade
 - Strong correlation between attitudes towards country's direction and GEL-USD exchange rate
- Extreme dissatisfaction about the state of the country's economy;
 - Top issues economic ones -- jobs, rising prices and inflation, and poverty
 - Only a third feel they are better off economically than their parents' generation
 - Almost half believe they can afford less than five years ago
 - Half of Georgians didn't have enough funds to pay for utilities in the past six months

Main findings

- Overall, majority of Georgians are satisfied with the quality of healthcare, but high costs
 - Over the past year, half of the population had to postpone medical treatment and couldn't buy medicine because they couldn't afford it
- The vast majority (83 percent) continue to believe that parliament should include at least 30 percent women, and approve of a mandatory gender quota
- Stable support for the country's EU and Euro-Atlantic goals: EU support at 78 percent, NATO support at 71 percent





Strong correlation between "Wrong Direction" and Gel to USD exchange rate














Overall, who do you think is primarily responsible for economic problems in Georgia? (q29)



Which of the following statement better represents your opinion? (q30)










Is your generation worse off, the same or better off economically than your parents' generation? (q37)





Is your generation worse off, the same or better off economically than your parents' generation? (q37 X Settlement, Age)






If yes, is this money the main source of income for your family? (q40) - of the 12% who has family member working abroad














Speaking about the past 6 months, did you ever not have enough money to pay for utilities? (q35)






Unemployment status


Reasons for unemployment

If unemployed, which statement applies to you? (q43) - of the 61% who considers themselves unemployed




















If you had extra money for saving each month, in which currency would you prefer to keep this money? (q50) - Open Question





























If, yes, how much do you trust this facility to give you the healthcare you need? (q64) - of the 90% who have a medical facility available in 30 minutes from home









Do you currently use state universal healthcare? (q67)







In general how much do you trust or distrust the medical diagnosis that doctors give in Georgia? (q70)





















Do you approve or disapprove of Georgian government's stated goal to join the EU? (q10)




EU membership support

Do you approve or disapprove of Georgian government's stated goal to join the EU? (q10 X Settlement, Age, Gender)




EU membership support - Minorities

Do you approve or disapprove of Georgian government's stated goal to join the EU? (q10) Minority settlements










Dissolution of USSR




How often do you use the Internet? Do you use the Internet ... (q75)


How often do you use the Internet? Do you use the Internet ... (q75 X Settlement, Age)
