RESEARCH METHODOLOGY

SAMPLE DESIGN

Sample frame: Population of Serbia 18+ Type of sample: Three stage random representative: Unit of the first stage: Territory of polling place Unit of the second stage: Households (SRSWoR – random walk) Unit of the third stage: Respondents within a household (Random selection of the respondent)

SAMPLE SIZE

1,027 respondents Margin of error: <u>+</u> 3.1%

TIME FRAME

November 2018


INTERVIEWER NETWORK

Field questionnaire – average duration 20 minutes



HALF ARE MISINFORMED ABOUT THE ELECTORAL SYSTEM IN SERBIA


Which electoral system do Serbian citizens use to vote for parliamentary representatives?


MAJORITY WOULD LIKE AN MP THAT REPRESENTS THEIR GEOGRAPHICAL AREA


On a scale from 1 to 5, how important is it for you to have a representative in Parliament from your area?

Do you believe that all towns and municipalities in Serbia have a representative in Parliament?






Currently, 102 of 174 are represented


ABOUT HALF KNOW THE NUMBER OF MPS IN PARLIAMENT

Do you think that Mayor of your town / President of your municipality should be elected by citizens or the local assembly?



WOMEN IN PARLIAMENT


ONLY 20 PERCENT BELIEVE THERE IS AN EQUAL NUMBER OF MEN AND WOMEN MPS

Do you think that both genders are currently equally represented in Parliament?




MORE THAN HALF THINKS EQUAL REPRESENTATION IN THE PARLIAMENT IS IMPORTANT

MOST BELIEVE GENDER REPRESENTATION IS IMPORTANT BECAUSE OF GENDER EQUALITY IN GENERAL


Why do you think gender equality in the Parliament is important? (Open ended)

Do you know the percentage of women in the Parliament of the Republic of Serbia?




Currently, 37% of MPs are women


90 PERCENT OF THE POPULATION HAS NEVER COMMUNICATED WITH MPS

THOSE WHO CONTACTED MPs MAINLY USED PERSONAL RELATIONSHIPS


How do you communicate with MPs?
