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Why We Conduct Polls?

Foster the development of more responsive policies and governance;

Help stakeholders diagnose and address issues of public concern;

Ieaders from across the political spectrum have reported that the polls are important to their work and encourage continued polling;

Inclusive process: the polling instrument was developed in consultation with parties, government, and civil society leaders;

Information about the poll

Fieldwork dates: June 8 – July 6, 2016

➤ 4,113 completed interviews

A nationally representative sample including oversampled areas of the Capital, Urban, Rural and minority settlements

The average margin of error is +/- 2,1%

Methodology

Sample design

NDI and CRRC use a complex survey design:

- Stratification dividing population in relatively homogenous subgroups
- Clustering randomly selecting small geographic areas for each subgroup (stratum)
- > Households are selected via random route sampling
- Respondents are selected using a Kish table
- Randomly selected households and individuals are not substituted
- All interviews were conducted face-to-face, in Georgian, Armenian and Azeri.

How NDI Survey is Conducted

At the first stage, CRRC randomly selects voting precincts in Georgia. Interviewers are sent there with given starting point, directions for walking, step size, number of contacts.



Interviewer randomly selectes households according to the given step size, e.g. every 3rd, 5th, 8th... 2

The respondent is selected randomly, with special method - so called Kish grid. Selected respondent cannot be replaced.

Interviewer conducts an interview with the selected household member. Intervewer uses tablet computer and a special software.

Interviewer submits the results via the internet to the special server.

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





CRRC cleans and analyses collected data, which later is presented to the public.







In which direction is Georgia going? (q4 X Settlement)






Since June 2014, taking everything into account, living conditions in your city/village ...? (q6 X Settlement)





How much do you agree or disagree that the current government is making the changes that matter to you? (q5)




How much do you agree or disagree that the current government is making the changes that matter to you? (q5)




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How much do you agree or disagree that the current government is making the changes that matter to you? (q5 X Settlement)














Speaking about a monetary spending/income last month, to which of the following groups does your household belong? (q48, q52)








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Do you approve or disapprove of Georgian government's stated goal to join the EU? (q13 X Age)




Do you approve or disapprove of Georgian government's stated goal to join the EU? (q13 X Settlement)






Do you agree or disagree that Visa free travel with EU will benefit people like you? (q15)


Do you agree or disagree that Visa free travel with EU will benefit people like you? (q15 X Age)






Do you agree or disagree that Visa free travel with EU will benefit people like you? (q15 X If elections were held tomorrow would you say you are decided or undecided?)


Do you approve or disapprove of Georgian government's stated goal to join NATO? (q17)



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
Do you approve or disapprove of Georgian government's stated goal to join NATO? (q17 X Settlement)




Do you approve or disapprove of Georgian government's stated goal to join NATO? (q17 X If elections were held tomorrow would you say you are decided or undecided?)










Which of the following statements you agree with? (q14 X Age)








In your opinion, Georgia's foreign policy should be ...? (q16 X Age)






Foreign Policy: Advanced Analyses


General information

- The analysis is based on multinomial logistics regression model predicting respondent's foreign policy preference through his/her socio-economic, demographic and attitudinal peculiarities
- Dependent variable:
 - Georgia will benefit from European and Euroatlantic integration versus Georgia will benefit if it abandons European and Euroatlantic integration
- Independent variables (predictors)
 - Respondent's age, attained level of education, exposure to foreign TV channels, index of respondent's well-being (measuring the existence of household item)
- Data is weighted and survey-set


 Respondents with higher education have the highest probability of being for Georgia's European and Euroatlantic integration




 As respondent's age increases, the support for Eurointegration wanes. However, along with age, increases likelihood that the respondent will prefer improving relations with Russia



 Along with the index of material well-being, respondents' support of Eurointegration increases.




- If voters receive information from foreign TV channels, they are more likely to be pro-Russian
- Effect is still profound when controlling for the respondent's ethnicity




What are your main sources of information for receiving news about Georgian politics and current events? (q39/q40)




How often do you use the Internet? (q47)




Do you watch coverage of Georgian politics and current events on the following channels? (q42)




In general, how much do you trust or distrust coverage of news and current affairs on the following TV channels? (q43)



Overall, how well do you think Georgian TV journalists inform the population about what is actually going on in Georgia? (q41)




Do you watch coverage of news and current affairs on non-Georgian channels? (q44 X Age)




