Why We Conduct Polls?

Foster the development of more responsive policies and governance;

Help stakeholders diagnose and address issues of public concern;

leaders from across the political spectrum have reported that the polls are important to their work and encourage continued polling;

Inclusive process: the polling instrument was developed in consultation with parties, government, and civil society leaders;

Information about the poll

Fieldwork dates: November 4 – December 4, 2016

➤3,141 completed interviews

A nationally representative sample including oversampled areas of the Capital, Urban, Rural, minority settlements, Kutaisi, Batumi, Zugdidi and Akhaltsikhe cities

Minority stratum consists of population of those settlements, where ethnic minorities (mostly Armenians and Azeri) make at least 40% of the total settlement population. Settlements within this stratum are dispersed through Kvemo Kartli, Samtskhe-Javakheti and kakheti regions

The average margin of error is +/- 1,8%

Methodology

Sample design

NDI and CRRC use a complex survey design:

- Stratification dividing population in relatively homogenous subgroups
- Clustering randomly selecting small geographic areas for each subgroup (stratum)

Households are selected via random route sampling

- Respondents are selected using a Kish table
- Randomly selected households and individuals are not substituted
- All interviews were conducted face-to-face, in Georgian, Armenian and Azeri.

How NDI Survey is Conducted

At the first stage, CRRC randomly selects voting precincts in Georgia. Interviewers are sent there with given starting point, directions for walking, step size, number of contacts.

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
The respondent is selected randomly, with special method - so called Kish grid. Selected respondent cannot be replaced.

Interviewer randomly selectes households according to the given step size, e.g. every 3rd, 5th, 8th...


Interviewer conducts an interview with the selected household member. Intervewer uses tablet computer and a special software.


Speaking about the October 2012 and October 2016 Parliamentary elections pre-election periods, which of the following statements do you agree with? (q14)









If you were contacted, was it a candidate or his/her representative? (q18) - of the 45% who were contacted directly by the candidate or the representative




If contacted, on behalf of which party/candidate was this contact made? Accept all answers (q19) - of the 60% who were contacted by the candidate or the representative by any means




When did you decide which party to vote for in the parliamentary elections? (q23) - of the 77% who voted in the October 8 parliamentary elections or the run offs






Which of the following policies was the most important when deciding which party to vote for? (q36)




Thinking about October 8 parliamentary elections, how important or unimportant were the following factors in making your decision? (q37) Voters only. Part 1














Did you have enough information about where to vote? (q25)

Did you have enough information about the parties and candidates? (q26)




What was the main source of information about parties and candidates? (q27)






Did you vote in October 8 Parliamentary elections? (q21 X Settlement)







Did you vote in October 8 Parliamentary elections? (q21 X Age)




Did you vote in October 8 Parliamentary elections? (q21 X Gender)





Did you vote in the run offs on October 30? (q22 X Age)




Did you vote in the run offs on October 30? (q22 X Gender)






Did you not record your vote on any of the ballots? (q29) - of the 74% who voted in the October 8 parliamentary elections






How do you think the October 8 Parliamentary election was conducted/managed by the election officials (CEC, PEC, DEC)? (q33)



How do you think the run off was conducted/managed by the election officials (CEC, PEC, DEC)? (q34)




Would you support or not electronic voting, when people go to electoral precinct and vote using computer instead of paper? (q38)




When did you decide not to vote? (q31) - of the 23% who did not vote in October 8 parliamentary elections and the run offs




When did you decide not to vote? (q31 X Gender) - of the 23% who did not vote in October 8 parliamentary elections and the run offs




What was the main reason you did not vote in the parliamentary elections? (q32) - of the 23% who did not vote in October 8 parliamentary elections and the run offs



What was the main reason you did not vote in the parliamentary elections? (q32 X Gender) - of the 23% who did not vote in October 8 parliamentary elections and the run offs




What was the main reason you did not vote in the parliamentary elections? (q32 X Age) - of the 23% who did not vote in October 8 parliamentary elections and the run offs



Who is your majoritarian member in the Parliament of Georgia? (q40 X Voters Only)




What do you expect from the member of the Parliament (MP)? (q39)




What do you expect from the member of the Parliament (MP)? % of Yes (q39)




All waves are nationally representative of Georgian speakers. April 2015, March 2016 and November 2016 are also representative for minority regions.


What do you expect from the member of the Parliament (MP)? % of Yes (q39 X Party closest to you)



Overall, do you think the New Parliament (elected in October 2016) will work better, the same or worse than the previous parliament (elected in October 2012)? (q41)






How much do you agree or disagree that members of the new parliament will take into account opinions of people like you? (q43)


Do you agree or disagree that members of the new parliament will take into account opinions of people like you? (q43 X Party closest to you)




To what extent do you agree or disagree with the following statement: If you wanted to you would be able to easily arrange a meeting with the Member of Parliament. (q44)
